Note

1. Every Application shall be made through the certifying officer to the returning officer of the electoral area where the applicant is registered as an elector within ten days after the date of publication of the notice of nomination under section 26 of the Ordinance together with the recommendation of his/ her immediate head of the institution.
2. Every application shall be duly filled in as otherwise it is liable to rejection by the returning officer.
3. Every applicant will be informed of the decision of the returning officer.
4. The ballot paper and other documents of any applicant, whose application has been allowed, will be dispatched to his name and address as stated in his application, if he is entitled to function as a certifying officer or if he is not so entitled, under the care of the certifying officer whose official designation and address are stated in his application.
5. The expression "certifying officer" :
 - (a) in relation to any applicant who, being a member of the Sri Lanka Army or Sri Lanka Navy or Sri Lanka Air Force ;
 - (i) is the Commander of that Army or the Captain of that Navy or the Commander of that Air Force or is the officer in immediate charge of the unit or establishment in which the applicant is serving, means the applicant ; or
 - (ii) is not a person referred to in clause (i) of this subparagraph, means the officer in immediate charge of the unit or establishment in which the applicant is serving.
 - (b) in relation to any applicant who, being an officer or servant in the public service or the Central Bank of Ceylon,
 - (i) is the officer in immediate charge of any office means the applicant ; or
 - (ii) is not a person referred to in clause (i) of this subparagraph, means the officer in immediate charge of the office in which the applicant is serving ; or
 - (c) in relation to any applicant who is a candidate at a Local Government Election, means the Returning Officer for the electoral area in which the applicant is registered as an elector.

Instructions

1. The applicant should be eligible, under Section 39(B)(2) of the Local Authorities Elections Ordinance (Chapter 262) to be treated as a Postal Voter.
2. It is necessary to mention in the appropriate space in the application, the name of the applicant as shown in the relevant Electoral Register.
3. The application will be rejected if the details shown in the application do not tally with the Electoral Register.
4. The absence of the relevant Certifying Officer's signature, official seal and non-receipt of the application by the Returning Officer of the local authority area on or before the closing date will be grounds for rejection of the application.
5. The applicant should ensure that he personally completes the application.
6. The applicant should, before he extracts his details from the relevant Electoral Register, be satisfied that the details refer to the house in which his family members are registered as electors. If not an applicant can enter details of a person whose name resembles or similar to the name of the applicant. If the Returning Officer allows such application, the person whose name has been given in the application will be deprived of his vote. However, persons who erroneously apply to vote by post shall be guilty of a punishable offence.
7. A person who applies to vote by post in the name of a living or a dead person, or a fictitious person or in the name of another person commits an offence of personation under Section 82 A of the Local Authorities Elections Ordinance (Chapter 232) and becomes liable for punishment under the Code of Criminal Procedure Act, No. 15 of 1979.
