Local Authorities Election – MAY 06,2025 Process of marking the ballot

Notice to all Electors and Postal Voters who are eligible to vote at the Local Authorities Election to be held on 06th May 2025

- Every elector is entitled to one vote, which means one elector receives only one ballot paper.
- The Ballot papers issued to voters at the polling station are printed with only the names and symbols of the contesting Parties and the words "Independent Group" and the identification number and symbols in the case of Independent Groups. The name or numbers of candidates or wards do not appear on the ballot paper.

- You are kindly requested to mark only one "cross (X)" in the space provide on the right side of the name and symbol of the Party or number and symbol of the Independent Group you wish to cast your vote.
- It is imperative that you refrain from entering, drawing or writing any mark other than the "cross (X)" on the ballot paper, since the writing of any other mark can be construed as an attempt to disclose the identity of the voter.

Please mark your vote only with a cross.
