

ENGLISH TRANSLATION



DEMOCRATIC PEOPLE'S LIBERATION FRONT

CONSTITUTION

1. Objectives of the party :-

- 1.1. To secure the just and fundamental political, social, economic and cultural rights of the Tamil people in Sri Lanka, based on the right to self-determination of a nation, through a federal constitution
- 1.2. To reconstruct the homeland, which has been devastated by three decades of war, on the basis of a permanent and sustainable policy plan,
- 1.3. To fight against all forms of fundamental human rights violations in order to ensure the fundamental rights of other communities in the country and to maintain social justice.
- 1.4. To support the struggles for fundamental rights and social justice of communities that are oppressed on the basis of race, religion and class internationally.
- 1.5. To work through all possible means, excluding violence, to achieve the above goals.

2. Party Membership :-

- 2.1. All Sri Lankan citizens who have completed the age of eighteen years who accept the party's objectives and the party's constitution to achieve them are eligible to become party members.
- 2.2. Those who are admitted to the party will be admitted as ordinary members and life members. Ordinary members will pay an annual subscription of Rs. 100/-. Life members will pay a life subscription of Rs. 1000/-.

2.3. Ordinary party membership is valid for the period from 01st of the month of Tai to 31st of the month of Margazhi of the year.

2.4. Only those who have obtained party membership as mentioned above are eligible to be a member of the General Assembly, Central Committee and District Executive Committee or to participate in the election.

3. Party Central Committee :-

3.1. The Central Committee, the highest organ of the party, shall consist of twenty-nine (29) members.

a) Of these, seven (07) members shall be elected by the members of the General Assembly on the basis of seniority and positions held by them. The seven members elected for the positions of Party President, Secretary, Treasurer, National Organizer, Senior Vice President, Vice President, and Deputy Secretary shall be members of the Executive Council of the party.

b) Twenty-three (23) members to be elected to the Central Committee, including the seven members of the Executive Council, shall be elected by the members of the General Assembly of each district.

The number of members to be elected to the Central Committee of each district shall be determined in accordance with the ratio of the total members of the General Assembly to the district members of the party.

c) The remaining six (06) members of the Central Committee shall be appointed by the twenty-three (23) members.

3.2. In the event that more than one person is competing during the election of the members of the Executive Council, the election shall be made by secret ballot.

3.3. The members of the Central Committee shall be given the following responsibilities: Youth Wing Head, Women Wing Head, Social Development Association Representative, Media Section Head, and Media Spokesperson.

3.4. Women representation in the Executive Council shall be ensured.

3.5. The Central Committee shall meet under the chairmanship of the Chairman or under the chairmanship of the Senior Vice Chairman or under the chairmanship of the Vice Chairman.

3.6. The Central Committee shall meet at least once in three months. In case of non-attendance, the Secretary shall inform all the members of the Central Committee of the reason for such non-attendance.

3.7. An explanation shall be sought from a member who fails to attend three consecutive Central Committee meetings. If the reason for non-attendance is not valid, his membership in the Central Committee shall be terminated with the consent of not less than two-thirds of the members of the Central Committee.

3.8. If a vacancy occurs in the Central Committee, a new member shall be appointed with the consent of not less than two-thirds of the members present at the next Central Committee meeting.

3.9. A member of the Central Committee who has not attended more than half of the meetings of the Central Committee held during his three-year term of office shall be ineligible for membership in the new Central Committee to be formed after the next General Assembly meeting.

3.10. The Secretary shall convene the Central Committee if two-thirds of the members of the Central Committee request in writing, stating a special need.

3.11. The Central Committee may, from time to time, appoint an Election Action Committee and an Organizing Committee.

3.12. The quorum of the Central Committee shall not be less than one-half of the twenty-nine (29) members of the Central Committee.

4. Duties of the Executive Board Members :-

4.1. The Chairman -

- a) Shall act as the person responsible for all the activities of the party.
- b) Shall delegate powers to the Senior Vice Chairman or Vice Chairman to carry out the responsibilities assigned to him/her when necessary.

4.2. The Secretary -

- a). Shall be responsible for convening the Central Committee and the General Assembly by giving due notice, recording the proceedings of those meetings and preparing the meeting report.
- b) Shall prepare a report of the activities of the current General Assembly and submit it to the next General Assembly meeting.
- c) Shall maintain and protect the membership forms of the party members, details of membership fees. Details of members by district.
- d) Shall monitor and guide the activities of the district organizations, regional organizations and local organizations with the advice of the Central Committee and the District Organizer.
- e) Maintain contact with the Election Commission.
- f) When necessary, delegate powers to the Deputy Secretary to enable him to carry out the responsibilities assigned to him.
- g) If, for any reason, the office of Secretary becomes vacant before the next General Assembly meeting, the Deputy Secretary shall perform his duties until a new Secretary is elected. Regarding the election of the new Secretary. The new Secretary shall be elected by not less than two-thirds of the members present at a Central Committee meeting of 29 members to be held within a period of three months.

4.3. Treasurer -

- a) Shall act as the person responsible for all the movable and immovable assets of the party.
- b) He shall act as the Chairman of the Finance and Property Management Committee, which shall be responsible for safeguarding and managing all the movable and immovable assets of the party.
- c) It shall be the duty of the Central Committee to determine the membership of the Finance and Property Management Committee and to elect other members, except the Treasurer.
- d) He shall receive the quarterly reports of all administrative departments and submit the financial report to the Central Committee and shall implement all financial activities in the relevant administrative departments as per the decision of the Central Committee.
- e) He shall have the authority to issue vouchers for all funds received by the party and to make payments through vouchers with appropriate authorization.
- f) The Treasurer shall take action to withdraw funds from the bank accounts of the party through a cheque jointly signed by the Secretary or the Chairman.
- g) Prepare reports of financial activities and submit them to the Election Department annually with the confirmation of a qualified auditor and with the approval of the Central Committee at the General Assembly meeting held once every three years.

- h) The financial year of the party shall be from the first of April to the thirty-first of May of the following year.

4.3.1 Finance and Property Management Committee :-

- a) The Treasurer of the party shall act as the in-charge of the Finance and Property Management Committee.
- b) The financial projects implemented in the districts by the Finance and Property Management Committee shall be informed to the District Organizer.
- c) No member of the Finance and Property Management Committee shall be allowed to participate in or benefit from the financial investments of the party.
- d) All income received by the party shall be remitted to the district administrations as required in consultation with the Finance and Property Management Committee.
- e) The Finance and Property Management Committee shall be informed of any funds received from outside Sri Lanka.

4.4. The National Organizer :-

- a) Shall be responsible for monitoring, expanding and coordinating the activities of the Youth and Women's Sections.

4.5. All other officers of the Central Committee shall have the responsibilities and duties determined by the Central Committee.

5. General Assembly :-

5.1. The number of members of the General Assembly in each district shall be determined by the Central Committee in proportion to the proportional number of party members in each district.

5.2. The term of office of the General Assembly and the Central Committee elected by the General Assembly shall be three (03) years. The members of the

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General Assembly of the party shall be confirmed by convening the Central Committee within thirty (30) days before the completion of three years.

5.3. Notice of the General Assembly meeting shall be given to the members three weeks in advance. All members invited shall be paid-up members.

5.4. A special general meeting may be convened upon the written request of not less than two-thirds of the members or upon special reasons, with a notice of seven days in advance from the Secretary, containing only the relevant agenda.

5.5. If, due to extraordinary circumstances, the time of the general meeting needs to be changed, the change may be made with the consent of not less than two-thirds of the members present at the meeting of the Central Committee consisting of twenty-nine (29) members. The extension or reduction of the period of the general meeting shall be limited to one year.

5.6. The total number of non-resident members admitted to the general meeting shall not exceed ten percent of the total number of members invited to the general meeting.

5.7. The number of members increased to the general meeting shall not exceed ten percent of the total number of members of the current general meeting.

5.8. The quorum of the General Assembly shall not be less than one-half of the members of the General Assembly.

6. District, Regional and Local Organizations :-

6.1. All District, Regional and Local Organizations shall operate under the guidance of the Central Committee.

6.2. The District Organizer shall be appointed by the Central Committee, the Regional Organizer by the District Committee, and the Local Organizer by the Regional Organizer in consultation with the District Organizer.

63. The structure of the District, Regional and Local Organizations shall be decided by the Secretary in consultation with the Central Committee and the District Organizer.

6.4. The District, Regional and Local Organizations shall meet monthly to review and take action.

7. Rules for Members :-

7.1. If any party funds, movable and immovable properties, documents are in the possession of a member, all details of them shall be handed over to the Party's Finance and Property Management Committee.

7.2. All members are granted the right to internal party criticism. Criticism can only be made at the General Assembly, Central Committee meetings and district and regional executive meetings.

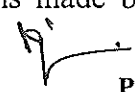
7.3. A member of the party is prohibited from participating in public protest activities involving fellow party members. Organizing events with the participation of those opposed to the party and participating in events so organized are prohibited.

7.4. A system of obtaining a response or solution should be adopted by submitting allegations and requests for clarification in writing through the Chairman or Secretary.

7.5. If any errors are found regarding an individual or regarding the decision of the Central Committee, a written report should be made available to the Chairman or Secretary.

7.6. Actions against those who violate party control will be decided by the Central Committee.

7.7. All members who are members of the District Organization, Central Committee, and General Assembly must abide by the decisions made by the



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majority of the District Organization, Central Committee, and General Assembly.

7.8. All documents and materials published at party events must be processed with the prior approval of the party executives. The above procedure must be followed even if funds are provided by outsiders.

7.9. If it is confirmed that party members are involved in the operation of social media sites related to the party, an explanation will be sought from them. Disciplinary action will be taken against them if they continue to act in an incorrect manner.

7.10. A party member can hold only one position in the party administration at a time.

8. Political Bureau :-

The Political Bureau shall consist of the President, Secretary, Treasurer, National Organizer, District Organizers, Youth Wing In-charge, Women Wing In-charge, and Media In-charge.

9. Decisions on the activities of the party's international branches :-

9.1. A three-member committee consisting of the President, Secretary, and Treasurer shall handle matters related to international branches.

9.2. All branches of the Democratic People's Liberation Front operating abroad shall be administratively subordinate to the Central Committee and shall operate separately.

9.3. The administrative structure of foreign branches shall be determined by the organizer of the branch in consultation with the members there.

9.4. In countries where branch administrations cannot be established, where the reasons for this are accepted by the Central Committee, a person who can act on behalf of the Democratic People's Liberation Front shall be appointed by the Central Committee as the country's activist.

9.5. All those who wish to be members of the Executive Committee must have accepted the resolutions of the General Assembly of the Party and have paid the membership fee.

9.6. The amount of the membership fee will be decided by the organizer of the relevant countries, after consulting the members there.

9.7. Only members who have paid their membership fees can participate in the decisions taken at the executive meetings and general assembly meetings.

9.8. Except for membership fees, all other fund raising activities on behalf of the party should be carried out only after obtaining the approval of the three-member committee consisting of the President, Secretary and Treasurer. All budget details of the funds collected for the needs of the party and for events using the name of the party should be sent to the Treasurer after the events are completed.

9.9. Any disputes arising in the activities of the branch and any discrepancies between the branch members should be resolved at the level of the relevant executive committee. The advice of the three-member committee may be sought where necessary.

9.10. Each branch should send a half-yearly report to the Secretary containing its specific activities and financial activities.

9.11. Branches and activists who wish to work together for a specific project can operate with the permission of the Tripartite Committee.

9.12. The Central Committee of the Democratic People's Liberation Front is given full authority to carry out all activities related to foreign branches and activists in other countries.

10. Regarding the provisions of the Constitution :-

10.1. The Central Committee will decide on matters related to the interpretation of the provisions of the Constitution.



10.2. This Constitution will come into force from 14.03.2026 and all previous constitutions of the party are repealed.

10.3. Whenever the Constitution of the party is used, its Tamil language version will be considered as the original.

10.4. Any part of the party constitution may be amended at a general meeting of the party or at a special general meeting convened to amend the constitution with the consent of not less than two-thirds of the members present.

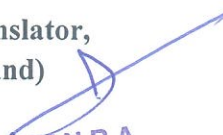
2.1. The length and width of the flag shall be in the ratio of 5:3. The above dimensions of the flag are suitable for a flagpole of 20' high.
