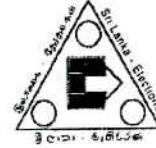




Election Commission



**Notice to the electors who wish to cast their vote by post at the forthcoming Parliamentary Election which is expected to be held in April or May 2020 and for which the Electoral register for 2019 will be used.**

- Any officer or servant in the public service who is to be deployed in election duties;
- any member of the Sri Lanka Army/ Sri Lanka Navy/ Sri Lanka Air Force;
- any officer or servant in the Department of Police/ Prisons;
- any officer or servant in the Sri Lanka Government Railway/ the Department of Posts/ the Department of Telecommunications/ the Sri Lanka Central Transport Board/ ..... Regional Transport Board;
- any officer or servant in the public service who has been or is likely to be appointed for the purpose of the election;
- any other officer or servant of the Central Bank of Sri Lanka who has been or is likely to be appointed for the purpose of the election;

who is unable or likely to be unable to vote in person at the polling station allotted to him, may make an application to cast his vote by post.

Election Commission requests the electors entitled to cast their vote by post to keep the following information of the Electoral Register 2019 ready in order to avoid undue delays in making applications for voting by post when the election is declared. Following information could be obtained from the respective Grama Niladhari or the District Election Office of your residence or from the official website of the Election Commission.
