Postal Voting Facility & Distribution of Poll Cards

Arrangements have already been made to issue and mark Postal ballots and to distribute Poll Cards in connection with the Parliamentary Election 2020.

02. Certification of postal voters lists will be done on 2020.06.18 and issuing of postal ballots and handing them over to the post will be done on the 30th of June 2020, 01st and 2nd of July 2020.

03. Accordingly, marking of postal ballots will take place at public institutions (except for District Secretariats, Election Offices, Police Stations, Security Forces Camps, Department of Civil Security Force and in the health sector) on 2020.07.14 and 2020.07.15 and the postal voters in the District Secretariats, Election Offices, Police Stations, Security Forces Camps, Department of Civil Security Force and in the health sector will mark their postal ballots on the 16th of July 2020 and until 12.00 noon on the 17th of July 2020. Postal voters who will fail to mark their postal ballots will be allowed to make the postal ballots on 20th and 21st July 2020 at the District Secretariat or at the Election Office in the district where their service station is located.

04. Arrangements have been made to hand over the Poll Cards of the Parliamentary Election 2020 to the post on 11th, 12th, and 13th of July 2020.

05. Distribution of Poll Cards will conclude on 2020.07.29 and those who will not receive poll cards by then may collect their poll cards by calling over at the post office relevant to the address with which they are registered in the 2019 electoral register, and upon verification of their identity.
