### Special Period of Time for Marking the Postal Ballots

A special period of time from 8.30 a.m. to 4.00 p.m. on 2020.07.24 and from 8.30 a.m. to 2.00 p.m. on 2020.07.25 has been allocated for those postal voters who failed to cast their votes at the respective offices of the postal vote certifying officers or on the 20<sup>th</sup> or 21<sup>st</sup> of July 2020, to mark their postal ballots.

02. It is notified hereby that the postal voters who have hitherto failed to mark their postal ballots can use the facility made available at the Election Office of the district where their work station is situated, to mark the postal ballots.

03. Certifying Officers who still keep packets containing unmarked postal ballots in their custody should take immediate action to return them to the Election Office of the district where the office of the postal vote certifying officer is situated on or before 2020.07.23.

04. The eligible postal voters should produce a recognized identification document (NIC/valid Driving License/ valid Passport/ Official Identity Card bearing the NIC number/ Temporary Identity Card issued by the Election Commission) at the postal voting centre to establish their identity to cast the postal vote at the postal voting on 2020.07.24 and 2020.07.25.
