ADMINISTRATION REPORT OF THE COMMISSIONER OF ELECTIONS FOR THE YEAR 1989

1. Introduction

1.1 The most important event of the year was the conduct of the Parliamentary General Election. Nominations for this election closed on 6th January, 1989, and the Poll was taken on 15th February, 1989. It became the first Parliamentary General Election to be conducted on the P. R. System with a preference marking for Candidates. Appointment of Members in proportion to the national total of votes received by each Party was another new feature. The Electors returned 196 Members elected on the District P. R. and 29 Members on the National P.R.

1.2 The Elections to the Local Authorities which had been postponed sine die from the original date of 15th August, 1987 could not be re-fixed during the year.

1.3 The Registration of Electors Act, No. 44 of 1980 was amended by the Act, No. 10 of 1989 to provide for persons who are deemed to be citizens of Sri Lanka by virtue of section 2 of the Grant of Citizenship to Stateless Persons (Special Provisions) Act, No. 39 of 1989 to apply for registration as electors during a period specially set apart for them upto 8th May of the succeeding year. This special facility is to be operative in the revision of electoral registers during the years 1990 and 1991 as well and cease to be operative on 31st May, 1991.

1.4 The revision of electoral registers in the Northern Province and parts of several other Provinces has been disrupted. Enumeration documents in respect of more than 600 Grama Seva Niladhari Divisions in 14 Districts have been destroyed both before and after enumeration. This necessitated the re-issue of Forms several times over causing a delay.

1.5 With the relaxation of the period for submission of applications for recognition of Political Parties, 12 applications continued to be made during 12 different weeks of the year. Three of them were recognized. Amongst them was an application from a Political Party which had 13 of its Members already elected to the Parliament at the General Election held on 15th February, 1989.

2. Registration of Electors (Amendment) Act, No. 10 of 1989

2.1 The Registration of Electors Act, No. 44 of 1980 was amended by Act, No. 10 of 1989. This Amendment was considered a logical corollary to the Grant of Citizenship to Stateless Persons (Special Provisions) Act, No. 39 of 1989. Apart from the provision of a special period for such persons to seek registration, this Amendment Act, No. 10 of 1989 read with the Amendment Act, No. 39 of 1989 appears to have drastically altered the basic procedure in the registration of electors. In the process, it has created serious reservations on the maintenance of accuracy and reliability of registration. It is therefore necessary to examine the background to these Amendments and their consequences.

2.2 Grant of Citizenship to Stateless Persons Act, No. 5 of 1986 identified a third category of persons of Indian Origin for the grant of citizenship in Sri Lanka. They are the 94,000 persons who applied for citizenship in Sri Lanka although they belonged to the 600,000 persons who were entitled to obtain Indian Citizenship. Along with this category the following three groups of persons were awaiting the conferment of Sri Lanka Citizenship:—

- (a) 300,000 persons under the Indo-Ceylon Agreement of October 30th, 1964.
- (b) 75,000 persons under the Indo-Ceylon Agreement of January 27th, 1974.
- (c) 94,000 (from amongst 600,000, who were entitled to apply for Indian Citizenship under the above two Agreements) who applied for citizenship of Sri Lanka.

2.3 Section 5 of the Grant of Citizenship to Stateless Persons Act, No. 5 of 1986 required that every applicant takes the Oath/Affirmation of Citizenship within the prescribed period. It was also necessary that—

- (a) every such person be registered in a register to be kept for the purpose, along with all required particulars ;
- (b) a certificate be issued to every such person including the names of children below 14 years at the time of issue ; and
- (c) such names be gazetted.

Citizenship was to be conferred on this 469,000 persons on the basis of the above stipulations within 18 months of this Enactment i.e. by 18th August, 1987. Since there was a deadline to complete this task, special arrangements were made by the Department for the Registration of Persons of Indian Origin to motivate the would-be beneficiaries to make their applications. They obtained the cooperation of the Estate Management as well as the Estate Trade Unions for this purpose. In fact during the period 1986 to 1987 teams of staff visited the Estates to expedite the process.

2.4 With all these attempts including visits to the Estates they could not trace the balance 323,000, leave alone to get them to make applications. The total number of applications received during this period when the above special arrangements were made was limited to approximately 39,270 and only 237,000 had been granted citizenship upto November 1988. Hence, it is clearly evident that the failure to complete this task was the absence of interest on the part of the persons concerned.

2.5 This was considered a situation serious enough to need correction by another Act. Hence, the Grant of Citizenship to Stateless Persons (Special Provisions) Act, No. 39 of 1988 was enacted. However, inspite of the fact that the circumstances under which this delay had occurred was so well known, as explained in paragraphs 2.3 and 2.4 above, paragraph 5 to the Preamble of this Amendment Act proceeded to define it as "due to various unforeseen circumstances, the said obligations could not be fulfilled during the aforesaid period . . ." and proceeded to justify the total

annulment of the procedure laid out in paragraph 5 of the Act, No. 5 of 1986. Consequently the maximum proof that can be called in evidence of Citizenship under section 2 read with section 4 of this Amendment Act is limited to only an "Affidavit".

2.6 Section 2 read with section 4 of the Grant of Citizenship to Stateless Persons (Special Provisions) Act, No. 39 of 1988 dispensed with the requirements of any application etc. and conferred citizenship on this group defining them merely as a category of persons. Section 2 of the act referred to above reads as follows:—

"2. Notwithstanding the provisions of any other law every person who—

- (a) is of Indian origin lawfully resident in Sri Lanka ;
- (b) is stateless ; and
- (c) is not within the 506,000 persons referred to in the Grant of Citizenship to Stateless Persons Act, No. 5 of 1986, who have applied to the Indian High Commission for the Grant of Indian Citizenship, and the children born to them after October 30, 1964.

shall have the status of Citizen of Sri Lanka with effect from the date of the commencement of this Act and shall be entitled to all the rights and privileges to which other citizens of Sri Lanka are entitled to by law."

(4) No person shall require the production of a Certificate referred to in subsection (1) for any purpose and an affidavit shall be accepted as prima facie evidence of the facts stated therein."

Undoubtedly it is an easy procedure. It is a procedure which has made it most convenient to a group of persons whose right to citizenship has been accepted. Substantially it has helped to resolve a long standing problem. There is no issue with this policy decision.

2.7 Yet there is one inherent defect in this whole system which cannot be overlooked or denied at least by this Department which has to face the task of registration of persons of over 18 years of age as Electors. There is no mechanism to identify them. As a result those who are disqualified under these provisions also can seek refuge under the affidavit and seek registration.

The grant of citizenship in any country is always preceded by a process of identification of the individuals concerned over a period of time. Identification is done in relation to a name, parentage and profession if possible and an address as sine quo non. There is always an obligation to take an oath of allegiance to the country which confers the citizenship. All these requirements help to fulfil a vital aspect of personnel management in a country namely that there is one authority on behalf of the State who identifies every such person and maintains a central record of such persons for reference. Such a record helps to identify those persons to the exclusion of anyone else within and outside the country.

2.8 All the above requirements had been met in all our Citizenship Laws, including the Act, No. 5 of 1986. An individual application was a pre-requisite in the fulfilment of the above conditions. The Special Provisions Act, No. 39 of 1988 obviously under the misnomer that the delay was consequent to such procedure dispensed with this all important requirement and granted citizenship to a group of persons defined merely by a process of elimination (exclusion from other categories) without the need for individual identification. This Act obviated the need for any state authority to identify persons in relation to a name, residence and Identity Card. As a result there is no authority today who can on behalf of the State, be held responsible to identify any such person as a person falling within this category to the exclusion of other persons. None of these problems would matter to any Government Institution unless some service is sought from them and if at all they would be few and far apart. But the Elections Department with a responsibility for the registration of every individual citizen over 18 years of age as an elector, has to face this problem. Therefore the issues that have to be faced by this Department have to be clearly surfaced.

2.9 Under section 4 of the Special Provisions Act, No. 39 of 1988, the affidavit is the only method for proof of citizenship. The affidavit is a declaration made on one's own honour. Only requirement is that the Declarant's signature should be certified by a Notary Public or a Justice of Peace or a Commissioner of Oaths. If the affidavit which supports a claim is properly presented, the Registering Officer is precluded from examining beyond it, to verify its truthfulness. It has to be accepted as "prima facie evidence of the facts stated therein" according to section 4 of the Amendment Act. The simplistic device of this affidavit has come to replace the Certificate of Citizenship which was awarded after inquiry and establishment of an individual identity. It defies one's imagination to think how a simplistic instrument of an affidavit was found satisfactory to be inter-changeable for a Certificate of Citizenship. This becomes all the more complex and confusing when the actual reason for the Amendment was that the beneficiaries could not be traced to obtain applications for the award of citizenship.

2.10 The reasons for the rejection of claims received upto May 8th 1989 ,creates further apprehensions on the affidavit as a satisfactory instrument.—

- (a) In a total of 325,558 Claims, affidavits in respect of 60,816 were incomplete.
- (b) A total of 28,383 carried different signatures purporting to be of the same person.
- (c) A total of 994 carried different signatures claiming to be from the same Commissioner of Oaths.
- (d) A total of 18,546 had been signed by the Commissioner of Oaths without the signature of the Claimant.

2.11 The degree of importance that can be attached to such affidavits becomes most questionable, when one finds that 47,923 affidavits had to be rejected as false declarations. Neither the Declarant nor the Affirmant had apparently known what they were about. With such a large number of doubtful signatures suspicion looms large as to whether they were all stage-managed. Some may even doubt whether there were any such declarants at all. Specially in the background of a failure to trace and obtain application forms for the grant of Citizenship under Act, No. 5 of 1986, it is justifiable to suspect whether the simplified procedure has reduced at least some of them to the ridiculous level of names and declarations without any "corpus" behind them. When section 4 of the Amendment of Citizenship to Stateless Persons (Special Provisions) Act, No. 39 of 1988 says that "an affidavit shall be accepted as prima facie evidence of the fact stated therein" it virtually reduces the inquiry of a Registering Officer to a mere farce and formality. It can lead to "false" registrations as well as multiple registration.

2.12 There are specific grounds under section 2 which precludes certain categories from claiming citizenship within this affidavit.

- (1) Section 2(a) of the Special Provisions Act, disqualifies anyone who is "not lawfully resident in Sri Lanka" from claiming a right as a Citizen. What is the evidence available to verify whether a person is lawfully resident or whether he is an illegal immigrant or one who overstays a Visa? An affidavit can provide a safe cover to any such person.
- (2) Section 2(l) excludes persons who are within the 506,000 who have applied for citizenship in India. Is there a single authority on behalf of the State from whom such a list of Applicants for Indian Citizenship can be obtained to verify whether any Declarant has made a false declaration on this ground? In the last few months, Registering Officers have already come across over 3,000 cases of Declarants who had obtained Indian Citizenship and thus disqualifying under section 2(c) but who yet for all submitted affidavits for registration. This information was available by chance. Would it have been correct to accept such affidavit as prima facie evidence? If this is a position that could be revealed purely by chance, Registering Officers should not be held responsible for registering Citizens of other countries as Electors because "prima facie evidence of the affidavit" cannot be rejected and there is no authority who can vouchsafe for the possible other status of such persons.

2.13 The entire mechanism of this simplistic procedure of a declaration by an affidavit of one's own citizenship has reduced the procedure to a doubtful formality as evidenced in the rejection of Claims given in Table II.

Apart from such false declarations, the provisions of this Act can result in repetition of names over and over again as new names in different places leading to duplications and triplications, with no mechanism for detection. The serious draw-back of the absence of a central register and public notice through a gazette notification as stipulated in section 5 of Act, No. 5 of 1986, becomes most pronounced in such instances.

2.14 It is therefor evident that the Special Provisions Act, No. 39 of 1988 is born with impurities which will definitely have adverse repercussions on the preparation of electoral registers. The Electoral Registers will carry the same degree of impurities and inaccuracies. It must be emphatically stated that when a similar proposal for the bulk grant of citizenship was considered earlier, this Department advised against the adoption of such a simplistic procedure because of the many abuses to which it can be opened. Therefore this Department should not be blamed for the inaccuracies and impurities that will creep into the electoral lists due to possible falsifications and multiplications on account of the serious draw-backs evident in the Grant of Citizenship to Stateless Persons (Special Provisions) Act, No. 39 of 1988.

2.15 With this special piece of Citizenship Legislation coupled with the most doubtful nature of control regarding the flow of people across the Palk Strait, the day is not too far away, when many a dubious person would be "deemed to be a citizen of Sri Lanka" on the strength of an affidavit. They have to be registered as electors as well. Hence, it is a matter of urgent and paramount importance to close this undeniable gap in the law, if Citizens of other countries are not to be registered as Electors of Sri Lanka.

3. Revision of Electoral Registers, 1988

3.1 The preparation of the Electoral Registers for 1988 which commenced on June 1st, 1988, was due for completion in early March, 1989. But it was delayed on account of the Presidential Election of December, 1988, because the "A" and "B" Lists had to be exhibited only in January 1989. Furthermore, the time schedule was affected both due to, work in connection with the Parliamentary General Election 1989 as well as the additional work in consequence of the Registration of Electors (Amendment) Act, No. 10 of 1989. This Amendment gave an additional period of time upto May 8th 1989 to a category of persons defined in section 2 of the Grant of Citizenship to Stateless persons (Special Provisions) Act to submit their claims for inclusion of names in the Electoral Register.

3.2 During the normal period of claims and objections in the month of January 1989 a total of 5,190 Claims and 10 Objections were received. From amongst this number, 1,974 Claims were allowed and 4 Objections were upheld. Please see Table I which gives the details of the Claims and Objections.

3.3 Consequent to Amendment Act, No. 10 of 1989, a total of 325,558 Claims were received before May 8th 1989. A total of 213,549 Claims were accepted. The rest had to be rejected for a multiplicity of reasons. Amongst them were false declarations, improper affidavits, inadequate details of Claim Forms, disqualifications under section 2 of the Grant of Citizenship to Stateless Person (Special Provisions) Act, No. 39 of 1988 etc. Please see Table II for details of these Claims and the circumstances under which some of them were rejected. There were no objections raised against the inclusion of any of these names.

4. Revision of Electoral Registers, 1989

4.1 The preparation of the Electoral Register, for 1989 commenced on 1st June, 1989. But its progress was low on account of several reasons. Preparatory work including the printing of necessary forms and conduct of classes were delayed both on account of the Parliamentary General Election 1989 as well as the general disturbances and work stoppages that occurred in the middle of the year.

4.2 Field enumeration had been adversely affected in all the five Districts of the Northern Province on account of the threats held out by certain groups who have their own mutual rivalries. In the Districts of Gampaha, Kalutara, Kandy, Matale, Nuwara-Eliya, Galle, Hambantota, Ampara, Kurunegala, Anuradhapura, Polonnaruwa, Moneragala, Badulla and Ratnapura enumeration work in more than 600 Grama Seva Niladhari Divisions was delayed on account of the disturbances that occurred at local levels. After commencement, enumeration had to be repeated in some areas because of destruction of documents. In respect of all these areas fresh forms also had to be issued. Altogether the period of field enumeration got extended beyond October, 1989.

4.3 Enumerators have also continued to demand more and more forms in respect of Estates and as well as a few other suburbs and town areas on account of the registration of those who qualified under the Grant of Citizenship to Stateless Persons (Special Provisions) Act, No. 39 of 1988. From amongst those who applied for registration during the special claims period upto 8th May, 1989, 34.4% had failed to qualify. Consequent to this Act, the number of households for enumeration should have increased specially in the Estates, Colombo and Kandy and the suburbs of certain other towns. It is likely that the recovery of forms from such households have caused further delay. The exhibition of "A" and "B" Lists have to be therefore undertaken in January, 1990 on account of these reasons.

4.4 From the progress in enumeration made upto the end of the year, the participation of political parties at this enumeration shows a low response. The presentation of National Identity Cards at the field enumeration shows a downward trend. This may have been caused by the reported losses of National Identity Cards. The registration of names per household appears to maintain the same averages as in previous years. Complete details are not yet available on account of the delayed enumeration.

5. Extracts of Electoral Registers

The demand for the issue of Extracts of Electoral Registers continued during 1989 as well, particularly in view of the fact that applicants for new employment had to produce certificates of residence for a continuous period of three years in the Electoral Districts from which they applied. The extract of the Electoral Register has now come to be the accepted mode of proving such residence, in the absence of any other parallel certificate. A sizable revenue has accrued to the Department from the issue of such extracts although the demand for such extracts has invariably come at very short notice and equally important, in very large numbers as well. At

times requests for thousands have been made within a day or two. At times this Department has been compelled to merely acknowledge receipt of the application to enable the applicant to present himself at the interview and issue the extract a day or two later, because it had been physically impossible to cater to such a vast number of applications. Hence, it is best that the Institutions which demand these extracts are more considerate towards both the job-applicants as well as this Department and give adequate time for the issue of these Extracts.

6. Parliamentary General Election—15.02.1989

6.1 Parliament was dissolved on 20.12.1988 while the results of the Presidential Election held on 19.12.88 were yet been received. Nominations under section 10(1) had to be therefore received between 31st December, 1988 and 12 noon on January 6th, 1989. Nominations were received by the Returning Officers of the 22 Electoral Districts. There were 1,393 candidates nominated by 9 Recognised Political Parties and 10 Independent Groups in the contest at the time the Nominations closed.

6.2 The Poll at this election was taken on 15th February, 1989, at 8,072 Polling Stations spread over these 22 Electoral Districts which encompassed the 25 Administrative Districts (Kilimochchi Administrative District forms a part of the Jaffna Electoral District while the Administrative Districts of Mannar and Mullaitivu form parts of the Vanni Electoral District). Difficulties were experienced in the conduct of the Poll in a manner somewhat similar to that of the Presidential Election. There were obstructions in 13 Polling Stations where the Polls were annulled. Four officers on duty died of injuries received from gun shots and bomb blasts. Several Police and Security men also died consequent to similar attacks.

6.3 This Parliamentary General Election was the first to be held on the P. R. Principle. An additional feature was the marking of preferences for candidates. After the Provincial Councils Elections of 1988, this Parliamentary General Election became the second election to be conducted on this basis. The total polled reached 63.6% out of an Electorate of 9,374,880, which showed an improvement by 8.28% over the Presidential Election held in December, 1988. The rate of Poll however varied between 84% in Ampara District to 19.17% in Matara District.

6.4 The counting of votes and preferences took place at 664 Centres, established mostly in and around Kachcheries. The counting of votes and the allocation of Membership was determined in respect of the 22 Electoral Districts by 4.15 p.m. on 16th February. But the counting of preferences continued upto late evening. The process of counting of votes and preferences under the charge of each Returning Officer was final for each Electoral District.

6.5 For the convenience of verification and release of results to the Media, a special Centre was established at the Agrarian Research and Training Institute. A group of senior officers was placed in-charge of receiving the details as and when they were ready at the District level. The CINTEC helped the computation of these results and the release to the Media, including the *Rupavahini*.

6.6 In view of the disturbances at 13 Polling Stations, the Poll was annulled under section 48A. The Commissioner of Elections invited the Secretaries of Political Parties to attend a discussion at 8.30 a.m. on 16th February, 1989, on these annulments. This discussion was attended by Secretaries/Representatives of six Parties/Independent Groups. The Commissioner of Elections informed them that he would instruct the respective Returning Officers to declare the Results because the annulment of the Poll in respect of these Polling Stations would not affect the results of any of these Electoral Districts. Please see Table XIX for results of the Parliamentary General Election.

7. Provincial Councils Elections Act

The Report of the Commissioner of Elections on the First Elections to the Provincials held in Sri Lanka in 1988 was tabled in the Parliament on 22nd December, 1989.

8. Referendum Act

The Referendum in the Eastern Province under section 37 of the Provincial Council Act, No. 42 of 1987 to make a determination on the merger between Northern and Eastern Provinces, had been fixed for December 31st, 1988. Later this was postponed to July 5th 1989 and further postponed to January 29th, 1990 by *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 564/3 of 28.06.1989. Most important requirement in this instance is the preparation of ground conditions necessary for the conduct of a Poll.

9. Recognition of Political Parties

In previous years, a Notice under section 7 of the Parliamentary Elections Act, was published in National Newspapers inviting applications from Political Parties for official recognition and a closing date for applications was stipulated. With the Amendment Act, No. 29 of 1988 certified on 16th August, 1988, new applications could be entertained during any period other than during the period beginning with the date on which the Notice of an election is issued and the date of its conclusion, or during a period of six months after the rejection of an application, if the same application is to be forwarded again. Under this new arrangement for the submission of applications, which seems more event-oriented rather than time fixed to specific calendar dates of the year, applications for recognition were received spread over 12 different weeks of the year. Following applications were recognised from amongst them :—

10. Vacancies in Parliament

Second Parliament under the second Republican Constitution was elected on 15.02.89. By the end of the year, 26 vacancies constituting nearly 10% of the Membership had fallen vacant. Four of the vacancies occurred consequent to deaths, while eleven each occurred in consequence of absence from sittings and resignations. It appears that the absence of some of them and resignations have

arisen consequent to a desire on the part of the Political Party concerned to replace some of them who were declared elected on 16.02.89. In some of the instances the Members so appointed themselves resigned, until the list of names under section 68(5) was exhausted so that the secretary of the Political Party could fill some of the vacancies with persons completely outside the Nomination List. Of the 26 vacancies, 4 vacancies occurred in respect of Members declared elected from the National List. In one instance, the vacancy had not been filled for well over nine months. It has to be noted here that, section 64(5) does not stipulate a time limit within which a nomination has to be made to fill such a vacancy, and even if provision is made for a limited period what alternative would follow in the event that the secretary, Political Party fails to respond cannot be made clear. Please see Tables VIII and IX.

11. Vacancies in Provincial Councils

Within a period of 18 months, 116 vacancies, constituting nearly 26% of the total Membership of the Provincial Councils, have occurred. Vacancies have occurred consequent to deaths, resignations and absence from sittings of Councils. Twenty-two Members have died. Seventy Members had resigned from Membership. Please see Tables X and XI.

12. Vacancies in Local Bodies

Local Bodies comprising of Municipal Councils, Urban Councils and Pradesheeya Sabhas fall into two categories. There are 10 Municipal Councils and 30 Urban Councils, for which Nominations were received, but where elections could not be held. In all these cases, the life span of the Councils elected to office in 1983 was extended. The method of filling any vacancies is guided under section 65A of the Local Authorities Elections Ordinance according to which the next in the Nomination List is appointed to fill the vacancy. In respect of the 02 Municipal Councils, 05 Urban Councils and the 68 Pradesheeya Sabhas in respect of which Members were elected uncontested in July, 1987, the vacancies are filled according to the amended section 65A of the Local Authorities Elections Ordinance according to which the Secretary of the Political Party has to make a nomination. During the year 1989, 208 vacancies have occurred in all these Municipal and Urban Councils and Pradesheeya Sabhas. There had been 42 deaths of Members, while 104 have resigned from Membership. Sixty-two Members vacated Membership due to absence for over 3 consecutive meetings or during 3 months. Please see Tables XII to XVII.

13. Order under Article 98(8)

The number of Members to be elected to the Parliament in proportion to the number of electors in each of the 22 Electoral Districts was gazetted under Article 98(8) in Gazette Extraordinary No. 588/2 dated 11.12.89. There is an increase of one Member each in Colombo and Nuwara-Eliya and a decrease by one each in Galle and Matara Districts.
