

ADMINISTRATION REPORT OF THE COMMISSIONER OF ELECTIONS FOR THE YEAR 1994

1. Introduction

1.1. The year 1994 was a busy year with Local Elections in one province and Provincial Elections in another, immediately followed with the Tenth Parliamentary General Election and the Third Presidential Election of Sri Lanka. The first two elections overlapped into each other. Nominations for the Local Elections in the Eastern Province, twice postponed in 1993, closed on January 12th, 1994. This election was held on March 1st, 1994. Meanwhile the nomination for the Southern Province Provincial Council closed on January 25th, 1994 and the Election was held on March 24th, 1994. The Ninth Parliament was dissolved on June 24, 1994. Nominations closed on July 11th, 1994. The Election was held on August 16th, 1994. Shortly thereafter, the order under Section 2 for the Third Presidential Election was issued on September 17th, 1994 and the Nominations were received on October 7th, 1994. This Election was held on November 9th, 1994.

1.2. The revision of the electoral registers for 1994 commenced on June 1st. Other than in some parts of the Colombo and Dehiwala, Mt. Lavinia Municipal Areas, the field enumeration was completed before the Presidential Election of 1994. The civil disturbances in the Northern Province continued to disrupt the field enumeration work in the Northern Province, but facilities were yet available for the electors to register themselves.

1.3. During the year under review 8 vacancies occurred in the Membership of the 9th Parliament, on account of the resignation from Membership. Only 6 vacancies had been filled at the time of the dissolution of Parliament. During the year under review 19 vacancies occurred in the Membership of the 10th Parliament, 12 due to resignation from Membership and 6 due to death. One vacancy occurred after the Presidential Election of 1994 due to the succession of the incumbent Prime Minister to the Office of the President. Seventeen vacancies were filled in terms of the Constitution and the Parliamentary Elections Act, No. 1 of 1981. The Secretary of the Political Party concerned had been informed to submit nominations for the unfilled 2 vacancies.

1.4. There were seventy-nine vacancies in the membership of the Provincial Councils, other than in the Northern and Eastern Provinces Provincial Council which stands dissolved under the Provincial Council (Amendment) Act, No. 27 of 1990, 77 were filled during the year under review.

1.5. During this year twenty-three political parties applied for recognition under Section 7 of the Parliamentary Elections Act. Twenty of these applications were rejected. In response to a notice published under Section 27(3) of the Local Authorities Elections Ordinance thirteen applications were received. Four of these applications were rejected. Inquiries into other applications are pending.

- 1.6. The Select Committee of the Parliament appointed to examine the Reports of the Commissioner of Elections on the Presidential and Parliamentary Elections held in 1988 and 1989, had several meetings. This Select Committee lapsed due to the dissolution of Parliament.

2. The Registration of Electors Act, No. 44 of 1980

2.1. *Revision of Electoral Registers — 1993*

The preparation of the 1993 electoral registers was completed on May 20th, 1994, on completion of inquiries into claims and objections. The number of claims and objections received at this revision was 59,313 and 2,187 respectively, of which 32,197 claims were accepted and 592 objections were upheld. The register so prepared was statutorily certified on May 27th, 1994. Please refer Table I.

2.2. *Revision of Electoral Registers — 1994*

The revision of electoral registers for the year 1994, commenced on June 1st 1994. The instruction classes to enumerators were held in all the districts in the last week of May and the first week of June 1994, other than in the Electoral district of Jaffna. The programme of field enumeration was disrupted due to the two National Elections. The enumeration in Colombo and Dehiwala-Mt. Lavinia Municipal area was completed during the latter part of November. The Assistant Commissioners of Elections couldn't undertake field checking of enumeration due to the work load of the two National Elections. The typing and the preparation of "A" and "B" lists for exhibition during the period from December 1st, 1994 to December 28th, 1994 for claims and objections, were completed by the end of November, 1994.

2.3. *Comparison of the Electoral Strength in Electoral Districts*

The increase in the electorate from 1992 to 1993 has been 1.135% reaching a total 10,945,065 electors. Please refer Table II for a comparative statement of the two years. However, there are differences in registration of Electors amongst the Electoral Districts. It is in proportion to such changes in the electoral strength that changes occur in the number of members to be elected to Parliament, as determined annually, under Article 98(8) of the Constitution. Please refer Table III for a comparative statement of the electors in the 160 Polling Divisions arranged according to the twenty-two Electoral Districts for the period 1984 to 1993.

2.4. *Classification of Households*

An analysis of households by electoral strength is undertaken in order to identify any households with large increases. This practice which commenced in 1985 has been of immense assistance to the Registering Officers to correct any errors or stall any attempts at deliberate falsification of registers by the households. Please refer Table V for the classification of households according to the number of names in each household for the year 1993.

2.5. *National Identity Cards*

The practice of obtaining the number of the National Identity Card at the revision of electoral registers commenced in 1984. This showed an increase of 7.97% in 1993 compared with 1992. Please refer Table VI and VII for details on production of National Identity Cards at the annual revision of electoral registers in 1994 and a comparative statement for the years 1984 to 1993.

2.6. *Participation of Political Parties*

Though an opportunity has been provided for the recognized political parties to nominate agents to supervise the field enumeration of electors, the response appears to have been limited. Please refer Table IV for details.

3. **Extracts of Electoral Registers**

The demand for the extracts of electoral registers arises mainly from an attempt to prove residence. However, residence is only one qualification for registration as an elector and that too is considered as ordinary residence. A person can claim to have more than one residence at a time consequent to the nature of his life and vocation. Because of this reason, the issue of an extract is always qualified by the proviso that it is not a certificate of residence. Nevertheless in the absence of the Householders List people have come to depend on the extracts of the electoral register for proof of residence. The exposure of the electoral register to be used for purposes other than elections, seemed to have an adverse effect on the purity of the electoral register. The one and only expectation in the preparation of electoral register is the conduct of elections. To the extent that demands are placed on electoral extracts for other purposes, such expectations get diversified. During the year under review 25,962 extracts have been issued and the total income derived was Rs. 345,433.50. Please see Table VIII for a comparative statement of the issue of the Electoral Extracts, during the years 1988 to 1994.

4. **Order under Article 98(8) of the Constitution**

The Order under Article 98(8) of the Constitution was published in *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 824/10 dated June 23rd, 1994. This order was based on the certified electoral register of 1993. Please refer Table XIV for the allocation of the number of members to be elected from amongst the twenty-two electoral districts. Please refer Table XV for a comparative statement of this allocation from its inception in 1982. The allocation based on the 1993 electoral register, has resulted in a decrease by one each in Colombo and Digamadulla Districts and an increase of one each in Gampaha and Nuwara-Eliya Districts.

5. **Vacancies in the Parliament**

5.1. *Vacancies in the Ninth Parliament*

Eight vacancies occurred in the membership of the Parliament during the period from January 1st, 1994 to June 24th, 1994, upto the time of dissolution of the Parliament. All of them had been created on account of resignation from the membership of the Parliament. Only six vacancies had been filled at the time of dissolution of the Parliament.

In addition to the above vacancies, ten more vacancies of which eight had occurred in Jaffna District and two in Trincomalee District in the year 1990 continued to remain unfilled. Although the Group Leaders of these Independent Groups had been noticed to make the nominations, there was no response from them, up to the time of the dissolution of the Parliament. Please refer Table IX.

5.2. *Vacancies in the Tenth Parliament*

Nineteen vacancies occurred in the membership of the 10th Parliament. Twelve of them had been created on account of resignation from the membership of the Parliament. Six vacancies occurred due to death of members. The other due to the succession of the incumbent Prime Minister to the office of the President. Seventeen out of nineteen were filled during this year. The Secretary of the political party has been ordered to submit nomination for the 2 vacancies. Please refer Table IX.

6. **Parliamentary General Election—16.08.1994**

6.1. Ninth Parliament was dissolved in June 24th, 1994. Nominations under Section 10(1) had to be therefore received between July 4th, 1994 and 12 noon on July 11th, 1994. Nominations were received by the Returning Officers of the 22 Electoral Districts. There were 1,440 candidates nominated by the 13 Recognized Political Parties and 26 Independent Groups in the contest at the time the Nominations were closed. Four nominations submitted by three Political Parties in two Electoral Districts, and four nominations of four Independent Groups in respect of four Electoral Districts, have been rejected.

6.2. The Poll at this election was taken on August 16th, 1994 at 9,579 Polling Stations spread over these 22 Electoral Districts which encompassed the 25 Administrative Districts (Kilinochchi Administrative District forms a part of the Jaffna Electoral District while the Administrative Districts of Mannar and Mullaitivu form part of the Vanni Electoral District). Some difficulties were experienced in the conduct of the election in the Northern Province.

6.3. The total polled reached 8,344,101 out of an Electorate of 10,945,065. The rate of Poll however varied between 2.32% in the Jaffna Electoral District to 87.25% in the Ratnapura Electoral District.

6.4. The counting of votes and preferences took place at 1,188 Centres, established mostly in and around Kachcheries. The counting of votes and the allocation of Membership was determined in respect of the 22 Electoral Districts by early morning on August 17th, 1994. But the counting of preferences continued upto late evening. The process of counting of votes and preferences under the charge of each Returning Officer was final in respect of each Electoral District.

6.5. For the convenience of verification and release of results to the Media, a special Centre was established at the Elections Secretariat, Sarana Mawatha, Rajagiriya, Sri Jayawardenepura. A group of senior officers was placed in-charge of

receiving the details as and when they were ready at the District level. The Computing Service Centre of the Institute of Computer Technology of Colombo University helped with the computation of these results and the release to the Media, including the Rupavahini.

- 6.6. In view of the inability to conduct the poll at 465 Polling Stations in the Northern Province, the Poll was annulled under Section 48A. The Commissioner of Elections invited the Secretaries and Agents of Political Parties to attend a discussion at 3.15 p.m. on August 17th, 1994, on these annulments. This discussion was attended by Secretaries/Representatives of four Political Parties/Independent Groups. The Commissioner of Elections informed them that he would instruct the respective Returning Officers to declare the Results because any re-poll in respect of such areas could not be decided upon, in view of the prevailing situation and even if decided to re-poll, it may end on a similar vote. Please see Table XIX for the results of the Parliamentary General Election.

7. Presidential Election — 1994

- 7.1. Order under Section 2 of the Presidential Elections Act was issued by the Commissioner of Elections on September 17th, 1994. Nominations were scheduled to be received between 9.00 a.m. to 11.00 a.m. on October 7th, 1994 at the Elections Secretariat, Sarana Mawatha, Rajagiriya, Sri Jayawardenepura. Deposits closed at 12 noon on October 6th, 1994. At the close of Nominations the valid nominations had been received from following six Candidates. Notice of Poll under Section 21 was published in the *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 839/9 dated October 7th, 1994.

- 7.2. Due to the death of Mr. Gamini Dissanayake, the Commissioner of Elections noticed the Secretary, United National Party under Section 22(1) to make a substitute nomination within three days. The secretary, United National Party, nominated Mrs. Vajira Srimathi Dissanayake as the substitute candidate. The Notice under Section 22(2) on the substitute nomination was published in *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 842/13 dated October, 26th 1994.

- 7.3. As originally scheduled the poll at this election was held on November 9th, 1994. Similar to the experience of the Parliamentary General Election 1994, the Poll was conducted only in 9,580 Polling Stations.

- 7.4. The total polled was 7,713,232 out of 10,945,065 electors of the country. The rate of Poll in the Districts varied between 2.97% in the Jaffna Electoral District to 81.25% in the Ratnapura Electoral District.

7.5. Counting of votes took place at 1,094 Centres mostly around the District Kachcheries. Counts were completed in all areas by early morning on November 10th. Release of results after computer entries took an extra time.

7.6. The Centre for the Declaration of Results was established at the Elections Secretariat, Sarana Mawatha, Rajagiriya, Sri Jayawardenepura. This centre received the District results from 8.00 p.m. on November 9th to 3.30 a.m. on November 10th, 1994. A group of Senior Public Servants assisted in the collection of Results. The Computing Service Centre of the Institute of Computer Technology of the Colombo University helped the Commissioner of Elections with the computation of results at this centre. The number of valid votes received by each Candidate and the computation for the Declaration of the President—designated are given below.

7.7. In view of the failure to poll in some areas, in the Northern Province the Commissioner of Elections invited the Agents of the six Candidates to meet at 8.00 a.m. on November 10th, 1994 at the Elections Secretariat, Sarana Mawatha, Rajagiriya, Sri Jayawardenepura. The Commissioner of Elections gave details of the number of votes received by each Candidate other than in several Polling Stations in the Northern Province where they failed to Poll.

He explained that the number that would have polled in these areas could not make any difference to the inter-relationship of the Candidates. The two Agents present at the meeting accepted this position. The Commissioner of Elections informed them that he had already annulled the polls in respect of such areas, but he would proceed to declare the results without a re-poll because it would not make any difference to the result.

7.8. Declaration under Section 56

At this stage around 11.00 a.m. on November 10th, 1994 the Commissioner of Elections was ready to announce the results live on the Radio and the Rupavahini. First of all he thanked the Staff, Police, Security Forces, Candidates and their Agents and the voters who extended their assistance in the successful conclusion of the Election. Then he explained the discussion with Agents of candidates on the annulment of Poll and the background in which he decided to declare the Results. On the basis of these figures, the Commissioner made

the following declaration of Results at 11.39 a.m. on November 10th, 1994 and declared the Hon. (Mrs.) Chandrika Bandaranaike Kumaratunga incumbent Prime Minister and the Candidate of the Peoples' Alliance, duly elected President under Section 56 of the Presidential Elections Act, No. 15 of 1981 at the election held on November 9th, 1994.

7.9. The Notice under Section 64(2) was published in the *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 844/10 dated November 10th, 1994.

8. Provincial Councils

8.1. Northern and Eastern Provinces Provincial Council

The Provincial Council of the Northern and Eastern Provinces which stands dissolved under the provisions of Section 5(3) of the Provincial Councils (Amendment) Act, No. 27 of 1990, continued to remain dissolved. Nominations

for this Council called for, by Notice published in *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 618/10 of 11th July, 1990 continue to be annulled under the Public Security Ordinance.

8.2. *Election to the Southern Province Provincial Council 1994*

During the year under review the Election to the Southern Province Provincial Council was held consequent to dissolution of the Council on December 31st, 1993 by the Governor. Vide *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 799/17 dated December 31st, 1993. Nominations called in January 4th, 1994 were received between January 18th, 1994 and 12 noon on January 25th, 1994 as notified in *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 800/12 dated January 4th, 1994. Altogether 11 Nomination Papers were received. There were four recognized Political Parties and one Independent Group in the contest with a total of 231 candidates. 55 were elected as members including the two bonus seats. The election was conducted on March 24th, 1994. Please refer Table X for the results of this election.

8.3 *Vacancies in the Membership of the Provincial Councils*

79 vacancies occurred. 77 of these vacancies were filled during the year. Please refer Table X for details.

9. Local Authorities

9.1. *Term of office of the members of the Local Authorities*

After the conduct of the elections to the Vavuniya Urban Council in the Vavuniya District and the Local Authorities in the Eastern Province in 1994, the terms of office of Local Authorities, retained a three fold character.

(a) *those whose term of office commenced on the 1st of July, 1991.*

This category included the 237 Local Authorities in respect of which, the elections were held on 11.05.1991.

(b) *those Local authorities in the Eastern Province and the Vavuniya Urban Council in Vavuniya District whose term of office commenced on 04.04.1994.*

This category included 40 Local Authorities in respect of which, the elections were held on 1st March, 1994. The date of commencement of the office of these 40 Local authorities had been determined as 04.04.1994, vide *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 809/1 dated 07.03.1994.

(c) *those Local Authorities in the Northern Province other than Vavuniya Urban Council in Vavuniya District whose term of office commenced in 1983 or 1987, falls into two sub-groups.*

- (i) *All Local Authorities which were returned uncontested in 1983 or 1987, in the Northern Province.*

Although the term of office of these Local Authorities were to expire on 31.12.1993, their period of office was extended to 31.12.1994, by *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 789/13 of 22.10.1993. The date of Commencement of the term of office of these Local Authorities situated in the districts of Jaffna, Kilinochchi, Mannar, Vavuniya and Mullativu in the Northern Province have been later determined as 01.01.1996.

- (ii) *Those Local Authorities in respect of which no nominations were received in 1987.*

Their term of office, has been further postponed to the end of December, 1995. On this basis, the term of office of these Local Authorities in the Northern Province (other than the Vavuniya Urban Council of Vavuniya District) is due to commence on 01.01.1996.

9.2. Elections to the Vavuniya Urban Council of Vavuniya District and all Local Authorities in the Eastern Province.

- 9.2.1. The elections to the Local Authorities held in 1991 excluded the Local Authorities both in the Northern and Eastern Provinces. Until the end of 1993 the prospect of holding elections were bleak. However, later it was decided to call for nominations for the Local Authorities in the Eastern Province and the Vavuniya Urban Council of Northern Province. These notices were issued on August 20th, 1993. It was rescinded under Public Security Ordinance vide *Extraordinary Gazette* No. 781/9 dated August, 26th, 1993.

Again the notices were issued on November 17th, 1993. This too was rescinded under the Public Security Ordinance, vide *Extraordinary Gazette* No. 794/16 dated November, 25th 1993. Finally the notices of Nomination have been issued on 22nd December 1993 for the election of members to the Vavuniya Urban Council of Vavuniya District and all Local Authorities in the Districts of Batticaloa, Ampara and Trincomalee of the Eastern Province. There were 40 Local Authorities consisting of one Municipal Council, 3 Urban councils and 36 Pradeshiya Sabhas amongst these Local Authorities.

- 9.2.2. Nominations were received during the period between Wednesday 5th and Wednesday 12th January 1994, for the election of members to these Local Authorities. Altogether 137 nomination papers were received out of which one nomination papers were received out of which one nomination paper was rejected. There were 7 recognized political parties and 5 Independent Groups in the contest with a total of 1,998 candidates. There were 816 youth candidates in this total of 1,998 candidates.

9.2.3. The poll at this election was taken on 01.03.1994 at 788 Polling Stations spread over these 40 Local Authorities.

9.2.4. The total poll was recorded as 554,439 valid votes constituting 64.82%.

9.2.5. Counting of votes and preferences was conducted in 93 centres in respect of these 40 Local Authorities. The results of the vote count were available by 5.26 a.m. on March 2nd, 1994 but the counting of preferences of 1,998 candidates continued up to late evening.

9.2.6 Out of the total of 816 youth candidates nominated at these elections 129 were elected as members which constitute 15.8% of the candidates. Compared with the total membership of 431 elected as members for all Councils this constitutes 29.9%.

9.2.7 Notice under Section 65(c) were served on the political parties and Independent Groups to nominate the Mayor/Deputy Mayor, Chairman/Vice Chairman of each Council on 04.03.1994. They were expected to submit their nominations by 21.03.1994. This notice was served on the UNP in respect of 03 Councils, SLMC on 06 Councils, DPLF on 01 Council and Independent Groups on 12 Councils. All of them responded within the specified time.

9.2.8 The members including the Mayor/Deputy Mayor, Chairman/Vice Chairman declared duly elected to these 40 Local Authorities were gazetted in *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 811/21 dated March 25th, 1994.

9.3 *Vacancies in the Local Authorities.*

During the current year all Local Authorities take a three-fold classification dependent on the nature of filling vacancies.

(i) The municipal and Urban Councils of which the elections were held on 18th May, 1983, and whose terms of office were periodically postponed and finally to expire on 31st December, 1994. There were no vacancies under this category.

(ii) One Urban Council and 15 Pradeshiya Sabhas in respect of which members were returned uncontested in 1987. There were two vacancies in the Pradeshiya Sabhas. These vacancies have been filled during the year.

(iii) Municipal and Urban Councils and Pradeshiya Sabhas elected to office on 11.05.1991, and whose term of office commenced with effect from 01.07.1991. There were 135 vacancies in this category with 15 in the Municipal Councils, 13 in the Urban Councils and 107 in the Pradeshiya Sabhas. From these vacancies 10 in the Municipal Councils, 12 in the Urban Councils and 89 in the Pradeshiya Sabhas have been filled. Respective political parties have been intimated to send their nominations to fill the other vacancies. Please refer Table XIII.

10. Recognition of Political Parties

10.1. Applications for Recognition

Twenty three political parties have applied for recognition under Section 7 of the Parliamentary Elections Act, during the year under review. Twenty of these applications were rejected. In response to a notice published under Section 27(3) of the Local Authorities Elections Ordinance thirteen applications were received for recognition. Four of these were rejected. Inquiries into other applications are pending.

10.2. Determination of rival claims of Recognized Political Parties under Section 10(1) of the Presidential Elections Act.

Rival Claims had been presented for recognition in respect of Janatha Vimukthi Peramuna. After inquiry, Commissioner determined that one such section was the Recognized Political Party.

11. Referendum

The referendum in respect of the Northern and Eastern Provinces Provincial Council which was to have been held on 28.08.93 has been postponed to 31.03.1994 in respect of the Eastern Province and 19.05.1994 for the Northern Province, vide *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 805/10 dated 9th February 1994. The referendum has been further postponed to 26, May, 1994 and 14th July 1994 in respect of Northern and Eastern Provinces respectively. During the year under review it was further postponed to February 23rd, 1995 and May 25th, 1995 in respect of Northern and Eastern Provinces respectively, vide *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 818/12 dated May 11th, 1994.

12. Assets

Vehicles

During the year under review a new car was bought for the use of the Deputy Commissioner at a cost of 1,280,000. A vehicle of the Government Agent, Ampara, was obtained on transfer while four other vehicles which belonged to the Agricultural Development Authority were obtained from the Ministry of Agriculture, Lands and Forestry. The Vehicle strength of the Department now stands at twenty four. A motor cycle was bought for the use of the Messenger of the Department.

13. Staff

13.1. New Cadres

Approval has been obtained for the following new cadres, during this year.

- (a) Deputy Secretary to the Treasury has authorized by his letter No. BD/355/57/19(G) dated 20.09.1994 the creation of an additional post of an Accountant under Financial Regulation 71.
- (b) Deputy Secretary to the Treasury has authorized by his letter No. BD/355/57/19(G) dated 26.05.1994 the creation of 8 Supra Grade Clerical Posts.
