

## **ADMINISTRATION REPORT OF THE COMMISSIONER OF ELECTIONS FOR THE YEAR 1995**

### **1. Introduction**

- 1.1. The annual revision of electoral registers, the filling of vacancies in the Parliament, Provincial Councils, Municipal Councils, Urban Councils and Pradeshiya Sabhas constituted the main activities of the Department of Elections for the year 1995.
- 1.2. The preliminaries in connection with the revision of electoral registers was completed on schedule throughout the Island, but the violence that erupted in North & the East resulted in the disruption of work in the Electoral District of Jaffna, and in some parts of Vanni and Batticaloa Electoral Districts.
- 1.3. During the year under review no vacancies occurred in the membership of the Parliament. The two vacancies pending from 1994 were filled during the year in terms of the Constitution and the Parliamentary Elections Act, No. 1 of 1981.
- 1.4. Although the arrangements for the elections to all Local Authorities which were due to be held before the 30th June, 1995, had been finalised, yet the term of office of these Councils have been postponed for a period of one year from the due date under Section 5(2) (B) of the Pradeshiya Sabhas Act, No. 15 of 1987 & 10(2)(B) of Urban Councils Ordinance (Chapter 255) and Municipal Councils Ordinance (Chapter 252).
- 1.5. Eight vacancies in the membership of the Provincial Councils, other than in the Northern and Eastern Provinces Provincial Council which stands dissolved under the Provincial Councils (Amendment) Act, No. 27 of 1990, were filled during the year under review.
- 1.6. Two applications pending from 1994 for recognition as political parties under Section 7 of the Parliamentary Elections Act No. 1 of 1981 were rejected after inquiry. During the year under review fifteen political parties applied for recognition. Twelve applications were rejected after inquiry and two accepted. One application pending inquiry.
  - 1.6.1. Nine applications pending from 1994 for recognition under Section 27A(3) of the Local Authorities Elections Ordinance, were rejected.
- 1.7. The Report of the Commissioner of Elections on the First One Day General Election to the Local Authorities held on 11.05.1991 was tabled in Parliament on 25th May, 1995.

## 2. Registration of Electors Act, No. 44 of 1980

### 2.1. *Revision of Electoral Registers - 1994*

Revision of electoral registers commenced on 1st June, 1994 and concluded on schedule. A total of 19,213 claims for the inclusion of names were received in respect of 22 electoral districts. There were 1,060 objections filed in 20 electoral districts. Inquiries into these claims and objections were completed on 10.02.1995. Consequent to inquiries held 8,000 claims were accepted and added to the lists. From a total of 1,060 objections, 442 were accepted as valid. Please refer Table I for the details of claims and objections under reference. The preparation of electoral register which commenced in January, 1995 was completed on 31st March, 1995. The 1994 electoral register has increased to 11,213,281 which shows an increase of 268,216 electors, when compared with 1993 electoral register. Please refer Table II for comparative statement of the electoral registers for the 22 electoral districts between the years 1993 and 1994.

### 2.2. *Revision of Electoral Registers- 1995.*

2.2.1. During the month of May 1995 instruction classes were held for the benefit of enumerators in all the districts other than in the Electoral District of Jaffna. Since all Grama Niladharies had undergone training and field experience at 1994 revision references were made to the nature of complaints that were received in the previous years and the need for compliance with proper procedure on the part of enumerators. This revision commenced on 1st June, 1995. Special enumerators were appointed in the Colombo and Dehiwala-Mt. Lavinia Municipal Areas and few places of Colombo District. The Enumerators work was test-checked in the field by the Assistant Commissioner of Elections. With escalation of violence and operations by the Armed Services have prevented the commencement of work in the Electoral District of Jaffna.

#### 2.2.2. *Exhibition of "A" & "B" Lists*

The typing and the preparation of "A" and "B" lists for exhibition during the period from 1st November to 28th November, 1995 for claims and objections were completed by the end of October 1995. During this period 17,549 claims and 698 objections have been received. Inquiries into these claims and objections commenced in December 1995. The number of claims and objections received shows a decrease in claims and objections when compared with 59,313 claims and 2,187 objections in 1994.

#### 2.2.3. *Participation of Political Parties*

All recognized political parties were invited to nominate their nominees to participate in the field enumeration of the revision of electoral

registers by a communication addressed to the Secretaries of all recognized political parties dated 21.04.1995. They were requested to send in their lists of nominations to the Registering Officer/Assistant Registering Officer of the respective district in time. Six political parties have responded to this request and submitted nomination in respect of 7,878 Polling Districts out of a total of 9,599 Polling Districts. The party nominees were given an opportunity to accompany the enumerator on his house to house visits in the field enumeration and any shortcomings or lapses were expected to be brought to the notice of the Assistant Registering Officer for corrective action. Please refer Table IV for participation of Political Party Nominees in the Revision of Electoral Registers - 1995.

#### 2.2.4. *National Identity Cards*

The proposal of the introduction of the National Identity Card for the purpose of revision of electoral registers and the issue of ballot papers at elections was accepted in two successive Select Committees of Parliament. In view of this decision the practice of obtaining the number of the National Identity Cards at the Revision of Electoral Registers, which commenced in 1984 was pursued with more attention. In respect of the year 1994 the returns indicate that 61.89% of the electors have produced the National Identity Cards at the enumeration. Please refer Table VI for details on the producing of National Identity Cards at the annual revision of electoral registers in 1994 and comparative statements for the years 1984-1994.

2.2.4.1. In view of the accepted proposal of the introduction of National Identity Card in the Electoral Process, the Cabinet of Ministers had approved the proposal on 4th May, 1995 that the National Identity Card be made mandatory for the purpose of Registration of electors at the annual revision of Electoral Registers.

#### 2.2.5. *Comparison of Electoral Strength in the Electoral Districts*

The increase in the number of electors in 1994 was 268,216. The increase between districts varied. The allocation of membership under Article 98 (8) of the Constitution for a given year is based on this electoral strength. The number of electors in 160 polling divisions arranged according to the electoral districts for the years 1983 to 1994 is given in Table III.

#### 2.2.6. *Performance of the Enumerators*

The total number of enumerators at this revision of 1995 was 13,376 of which the Special enumerators comprised only 105. All the rest were Grama Niladharies. All enumerators were under instructions regarding the time schedule of the completion of field enumeration and return of documents to Registering Officers. On this basis approximately 2,823 failed to return the enumeration documents in time. By the end of 1995, 164 enumerators have been reported for disciplinary action.



### 3. Extracts of Electoral Registers

The demand for the issue of extracts of electoral registers continued to be on the increase, as it arises mainly from an attempt to prove residence. A person can claim to have more than one residence at a time consequent to the nature of his life and vocation. Because of this reason the issue of an extract is always qualified by proviso that it is not a certificate of residence. In the absence of the Householders list people have come to depend on the extracts of electoral register for proof of residence. The exposure of the electoral register to be used for the purposes other than elections seemed to have an adverse effect on the purity of electoral register. The one and only expectation in the preparation of electoral register is the conduct of elections. During the year under review 36,543 extracts have been issued and the total income derived was Rs. 485,664.00. Please see Table VIII for a comparative statement of the issue of the electoral extracts during the years 1988 to 1995.

### 4. Order under Article 98 (8) of the Constitution

The Order under Article 98 (8) of the Constitution was published in *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 875/11 of 16.06.1995. This order was based on the certified electoral register of 1994. Please refer Table XIV for the allocation of the number of Parliamentary members to be elected from amongst the 22 electoral districts. Please refer Table XV for comparative statement of this allocation from 1984. The allocation based on the 1994 electoral register has resulted in a change between two districts of which Jaffna Electoral District decrease by one and Digamadulla Electoral District increase by one.

### 5. Vacancies in Parliament

During the year under review no vacancies occurred in the membership of Parliament, but two vacancies pending from 1994 were filled during the year in terms of the Constitution and the Parliamentary Elections Act, No. 1 of 1981. Please refer Table IX.

### 6. Provincial Councils

#### 6.1. Northern and Eastern Provinces Provincial Council

Under the provisions of Section 5 (3) of the Provincial Councils (Amendment) Act, No. 27 of 1990, the Provincial Council of the Northern and Eastern Provinces still continued to remain dissolved. Nominations were called for this Council by Notice published in *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 618/10 of 11th July, 1990 continue to be annulled under Public Security Ordinance.

#### 6.2. Vacancies in Provincial Councils

There had been eight vacancies in the membership of the Provincial Councils of which 03 occurred in Colombo, Kandy and Nuwara-Eliya Districts of Western

and Central Provincial Councils due to their being elected as members of Parliament. They have been filled. Four vacancies occurred due to death in Colombo, Kandy and Kegalle Districts of Western, Central and Sabaragamuwa Provincial Councils, also have been filled. The vacancy in Nuwara-Eliya District of the Central Provincial Council caused by resignation has also been filled. Please refer Table X.

## 7. Local Authorities

### 7.1. *The Term of Office of the members of the Local Authorities*

After the conduct of the elections to Vavuniya Urban Council in the Vavuniya District and the Local Authorities in the Eastern Province in 1994, the term of office of Local Authorities, retained a three fold character.

- (a) Those whose term of office commenced on 1st July, 1991.

This category included 10 Municipal Councils, 33 Urban Councils and 194 Pradeshiya Sabhas in respect of which the elections were held on 11.05.1991. The term of office of these 237 Local Authorities was, extended upto 30.06.1996 by notice published in *Government Gazette Extraordinary* No. 871/9 dated 17.05.1995 by Hon. Minister of Co-operatives, Provincial Councils, Local Government and Indigenous Medicine, under Section 5 (2) (b) of the Pradeshiya Sabhas Act, No. 15 of 1987, 10 (2) (b) of Urban Councils Ordinance (Chapter 255) and 10 (2) (b) of Municipal Councils Ordinance (Chapter 252).

- (b) Those Local Authorities in the Eastern Province and the Vavuniya Urban Council in Vavuniya District, whose term of office commenced on 04.04.1994.

This includes 1 Municipal Council, 3 Urban Councils and 36 Pradeshiya Sabhas of Batticaloa, Ampara and Trincomalee Districts, and Vavuniya Urban Council of Vavuniya District where elections were held on 1st March, 1994. Their term of office is due to expire on 03.04.1998.

- (c) Those Local Authorities in the Northern Province other than Vavuniya Urban Council in Vavuniya District whose term of office commenced in 1983 or 1987.

This include 1 Municipal Council, 3 Urban Councils and 27 Pradeshiya Sabhas totalling 31 Local Authorities.

In the district of Jaffna, Killinochchi, Mannar, Vavuniya and Mullaitivu in the Northern Province where nominations were not called since 1987. Although the term of office of these Local Authorities were to expire on 31.12.1993 their period of office was extended to 31.12.1994 by *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 789/13 of 22.10.1993 and their term of office has been further postponed by *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 851/2 of 26.12.1994 to

the end of December 1995 and the commencement of the new Council was scheduled for 1st January, 1996, has been further postponed to 01.01.1997 under Section 05 of the Public Security Ordinance by Her Excellency the President vide *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 892/17 dated 13.10.1995.

## 7.2. Vacancies in the Local Authorities

During the year under review all Local Authorities can be classified into 3 groups dependently on the nature of filling vacancies.

- (i) Elections to Municipal & Urban Councils which were held on 18th May 1983 and whose terms of office were periodically postponed and finally to expire on 31st December, 1996.

There were no vacancies under this category.

- (ii) Municipal Councils, Urban Councils and Pradeshiya Sabhas elected to office on 11.05.1991 and whose term of office commenced with effect from 01.07.1991 have been extended upto 30th June, 1996.

There were 116 vacancies in this category with 08 in Municipal Councils, 21 in Urban Councils and 87 in Pradeshiya Sabhas. From these vacancies 07 in Municipal Councils and 20 in Urban Councils and 84 in Pradeshiya Sabhas have been filled.

- (iii) One Municipal Council, 03 Urban Councils and 36 Pradeshiya Sabhas elected to office on 01.03.94 and whose term of office commenced with effect from 04.04.94.

There were 03 vacancies in the Municipal Council, 03 in Urban Councils and 22 in Pradeshiya Sabhas. From these 28 vacancies, 27 have been filled during the year.

## 8. Recognition of Political Parties

In response to a Notice published on 1st December, 1994 there were 09 applications pending for recognition submitted under Section 27A(3) of the Local Authorities Elections Ordinance. After inquiries held in January 1995 all these 09 applications were rejected.

During the year 1995, 15 applications for recognition of political parties have been received. 13 of these applications were from newly formed parties while 02 applications were from parties who had re-submitted their applications on the expiry of a period of six months under Section 2(D) of the Parliamentary Elections (Amendment) Act, No. 29 of 1988, after the previous applications submitted by them had been rejected. From amongst these 15 applications 12 were rejected after inquiry. One application awaits inquiry. Details of the recognised Political Parties are as follow :

## 9. Referendum

The referendum in respect of the Northern and Eastern Provinces provincial Council which was to have been held on 16th November, 1995 and 15th February, 1996 in respect of Eastern and Northern Provinces respectively *vide Gazette Extraordinary* No. 856/19 dated 03.02.1995 has been further postponed to 1st December, 1996 in respect of Northern Province and 16th November, 1996 in respect of Eastern Province, *vide Gazette Extraordinary* No. 893/13 dated 19.10.1995.

## 10. Workshop on Comparative Electoral Process in South Asia

- 10.1. Five Chief Elections Commissioners from South Asia met in Colombo for the first time to attend a Regional Workshop on Comparative Electoral Processes in South Asia. The workshop was hosted by the Commissioner of Elections of Sri Lanka in collaboration with the International Centre for Ethnic Studies, Colombo and was held at the office of the Commissioner of Elections on 2nd and 3rd September, 1995.
- 10.2. Justice A. K. M. Sadeque, Chief Elections Commissioner, Bangladesh, Dr. M. S. Gill, Elections Commissioner, India, Justice B. P. Shah, Chief Elections Commissioner, Nepal, Justice (Rtd.) Pakhare Alam, Chief Elections Commissioner, Pakistan, and Mr. Dayanada Dissanayake, Commissioner of Elections Sri Lanka attended.
- 10.3. Professor M. M. Haq, Department of Public Administration, University of Dhaka, Mr. Yogendra Yadev from the Centre for the Study of Developing Societies, New Delhi, Mr. Nilambar Acharya, Former Nepal Minister of Law and Parliamentary Affairs, Mr. I. A. Rehman of the Human Rights Commission of Pakistan and Mr. R. K. Chandrananda de Silva, Secretary, Ministry of Defence and Former Commissioner of Elections, Sri Lanka presented papers at this session.
- 10.4. The Workshop discussed wide-ranging questions regarding the electoral processes and electoral reforms in South Asian democracies and identified the following issues as crucial to holding "free and fair" elections and strengthening of democracies.
  - (a) Need for proper electoral rolls including the question of Identity Cards ;
  - (b) The need for independent and appropriately composed Elections Commissions with adequate power for effective control and supervision of the elections ;
  - (c) The role of judiciary in the electoral process ;
  - (d) The need for time limit in holding by elections to vacant constituencies ;

- (e) The need for an effective code of conduct for political parties and candidates ;
- (f) The need for internal party democracy and transparent account keeping by political parties ;
- (g) The need for greater participation of women in the electoral process and their representation in the elected bodies ;
- (h) The need for an appropriate ceiling on electoral expenses by candidates and parties and an adequate supervision mechanism ;
- (i) The need for registration of political parties ;
- (j) The need for annual meetings of South Asian Elections Commissioners and exchange of information amongst them.

All these and other issues were discussed in detail with study of country specific experiences. There is a need to continue and deepen this exercise.

## 11. Assets

### *Vehicles*

During the year under review four vehicles were bought for the use of Assistant Commissioners of Elections. Three vehicles were returned out of the five vehicles which were given to this Department by Agricultural Development Authority. Two vehicles belonged to this Department were handed over to the Procurement and Advisory Services Unit of the Ministry of Finance. Further another vehicle was released to Ministry of Defence. Thereby the vehicles strength of the Department now stays at 22.

## 12. Staff

### 12.1. *New Cadre*

Deputy Secretary to the Treasury has authorised by his letter No. BD/355/57/19(G) dated 12.10.1995 the creation of two posts of Typists under FR 71 by suppressing two posts of Data Entry Operators.

### 12.2. *New Appointments*

Mr. N. Thirugnanasambandar SLAS Class II Grade II assumed duties as an Assistant Commissioner of Elections with effect from 13.02.1995. Mr. E. A. Weerasena, Class II Grade —II S. L. Accountancy Service assumed duties as an Accountant in the Head Office with effect from 20.09.1995. Mr. E. Sumanasiri assumed duties as a Computer Programmer in the Head Office with effect from 02.10.1995.

### 12.3. *Transfers*

After serving the Department for nearly twenty years as an Assistant Commissioner of Elections Mr. R. P. E. Bandara SLAS Class I left the Department on 19th September, 1995 to assume duties as District Secretary of Kurunegala District. His period of service in the Department is recorded with appreciation.



#### 12.4. Promotions

12.4.1. Mr. Dayananda Dissanayake, Deputy Commissioner of Elections was appointed as the Commissioner of Elections on 17.02.1995 when Mr. R. K. Chandrananda de Silva retired from Public Service on 16.02.1995 to assume duties as Secretary, Defence.

12.4.2. Mr. A. D. de Silva, Deputy Commissioner of Elections was appointed as the Acting Commissioner of Elections during the period from 25.06.1995 to 16.07.1995 when Mr. Dayananda Dissanayake, Commissioner of Elections was away from the Island on an official tour of Ghana and United Kingdom.

#### 12.5. Retirements

12.5.1. Mr. M. R. Seinudeen, G. C. S. - Class I - Acting Assistant Commissioner of Elections, Trincomalee District retired from Public Service with effect from 03.04.1993 and re-employed him for nearly 2 1/2 years under contract basis. Mr. Seinudden left the Department after a period of 39 years loyal and devoted service to the Department.

12.5.2. After serving nearly 13 years as Commissioner of Elections and 35 years in Public Service Mr. R. K. Chandrananda de Silva retired from Public Service on 16.02.1995. He assumed duties as Secretary of Defence on 17.02.1995. His tenancy was a period of rapid changes and wide experimentations in the election laws and procedures namely Referendum, Presidential System of Election with preferential voting, Parliamentary, Provincial and Local Authorities Elections with preferential and proportional system of voting. During his period of service he has conducted 09 Elections at National Level to the satisfaction of all the Political Parties and Independent Groups.

Specially his contribution towards the construction of a magnificent Secretariat for the Department became a reality during the last days of his distinguished tenure is recorded with great appreciation.
