

## ADMINISTRATION REPORT OF THE COMMISSIONER OF ELECTIONS FOR THE YEAR 2000

### **1. Introduction**

- 1 : 1 The conduct of General Election to elect members to the eleventh Parliament, filling vacancies of the Membership of Parliaments, Provincial Councils, and Local Authorities, revision of electoral registers and action on applications for recognition of political parties are the main activities performed by the Department of Elections, during the year 2000.
- 1 : 2 Although the term of office of the tenth Parliament was scheduled to end on 28.08.2000, Parliament was dissolved on 18.08.2000. The parliamentary general election was held on 10.10.2000.
- 1 : 3 Vacancies were filled in respect of the Parliament and Provincial Councils, other than the North East Provincial Council which had been dissolved.
- 1 : 4 At the end of the terms of office neither elections were held nor vacancies were filled, during the course of the year under reference, in the 39 Local Authorities in the Administrative Districts of Ampara, Trincomalee and Batticaloa and in the Vavuniya Urban Council of the Administrative District of Vavuniya, consequent to vesting powers to administer the councils to the Divisional Secretaries under Public Security Ordinance. Further, neither elections were held nor vacancies filled in the local authroities in the Administrative Districts of Vavuniya, Mulativu, Mannar and Kilinochchi except in the Pachchilaipalli Pradeshiya Sabha in the District of the Kilinochchi, and the Vavuniya Urban Council of the District of Vavuniya where a second nomination was called on 03.02.1987. Hence vacancies were filled in the membership of the local authorities, during the year under review, only in all such authorities except in those referred to above.
- 1 : 5 Forty two Political parties submitted applications for recognition under section 7 of the Parliamentary Elections Act, No. 1 of 1981.

### **2. Registration of Electors Act, No. 44 of 1980**

- 2 : 1 *Revision of Electoral Registers, 1999.*— While enumeration of voters commenced on 01.06.1999, 27,724 claiems and 282 objections were received by the Registering Officers during the period of 04 weeks stipulated of submission of such claims and objection. Of these,

Registering Officers have accepted only 16,102 claims and 98 objections.

During this year too it was not possible to effect a door to door enumeration in the Electoral District of Jaffna. However, necessary application forms were distributed through Divisional Secretariats to those eligible by inter alia reaching the age of 18 years, to enter names in the current electoral register. Accordingly, the number of persons whose names were registered freshly in respect of the Electoral District of Jaffna was 22,476. Of these, 1,958 were those who have displaced from their residences in the Electoral District of Jaffna and are living in refugee camps in the District of Puttalam. In addition, steps were taken to refrain from entering 12,939 names in the Electoral Register for 1999 on the recommendation of the Grama Niladharis, who also recommended that their names be identified in the Electoral Register from 1998 and deleted as they were deceased.

The number of registered electors in 1999 is 12,071,062, which reflects 2.42% increase over the corresponding figures for the year 1998.

2 : 1 : 1 *Computerisation of Electoral Registers.*— This programme commenced in 1996 with the computerisation of the 1995 Electoral Register of the Colombo West polling division. It was possible to achieve progress in this regard by computerising the electoral registers of 07 polling divisions of the Colombo and Dehiwala-Mt. Lavinia Municipalities areas by 1998. 37.68% of the total number of electors in the Electoral District of Colombo for the year 1998 were registered within these 07 polling divisions. Steps have been taken to use computers in the preparation of electoral lists for all polling divisions (15 divisions) in the Electoral District of Colombo, for the year 2000, this may be considered an important landmark in the process of Computerization of the Electoral Registers. 11.48% of islandwide total number of electors registered for the year 1999 falls within the Electoral District of Colombo.

Some of the main advantages envisaged in the usage of computers in the preparation of electoral registers under the current legal framework are listed below:

- (i) Ability to update the Electoral Register only by entering fresh names at any revision i.e. those not registered in the previous year and deleting those ineligible names that were registered in the previous year, instead of typing the total number of names entitle for registration.

- (ii) Ability to utilise the time so saved by above process, to rectify shortcomings in the annual electoral registers.
- (iii) Ability to prepare speedily, the electoral register in Tamil as well, by using the same software.
- (iv) Ability to commence work at any point of time to update the data base which can potentially be used to enhance work related to the revision of electoral registers.
- (v) Ability to prevent multiple registration through the use of the National Identity Number with its Unique Number.

2:2 *Revision of Electoral Register – 2000.*— Enumeration of electors commenced on 01.06.2000. Mainly the services of Grama Niladharis were utilised for the enumeration of electors, 87 Special Enumerators were engaged in addition to the Grama Niladharis, in the Colombo and Dehiwala Mt. Lavinia Municipal areas. Action has been taken to distribute relevant application forms, through the Divisional Secretariats, enabling fresh electors (who have become eligible to vote by attaining the age of 18 years) in the Electoral District of Jaffna where the security situation is not conducive for the purpose of conducting door to door enumeration, to furnish necessary particulars for registration. Similarly action has been taken to obtain particulars of deceased electors, to identify them in the 1999 Electoral register and to desist from entering their names in the Electoral register for the year 2000. For this purpose, relevant information had been obtained through the Grama Niladharies.

Names of those who become eligible to vote by virtue of attaining the age of 18 years while having temporarily displaced from the North East Provinces and living in refugee camps in the District of Puttalam had been furnished to the registering Officer in the District of Jaffna to enable him to register their names along with those of their families, in the new electoral registers.

2:2:1 *Display of “A” and “B” Lists.*— Claims and objections in respect of the current revision were entertained from 30.11.2000 to 27.12.2000. 24,482 claims and 795 objections were received by the Registering Officers.

2:2:2 *Participation of recognised political parties.*— In response to the notification made on 23.03.2000 to Secretaries of Political Parties that an opportunity was provided for the observation of field activities related to the enumeration of electors, 20,627 agents were nominated in this regard by 07 recognised political parties.

The number of agents appointed this year and the co-operation extended by them in the discharge of the relevant function remained unsatisfactory, as that of the previous years. Please see Table number IV for details of the number of agents nominated by recognised political parties in respect of this revision of electoral registers.

- 2:2:3 *National Identity Cards.*— 70.8% of the total number of electors registered in the year 1999 had entered particulars of their National Identity Cards in the BC forms. In 1998 this percentage was 69.79%.
- 2:2:4 *Voting strength of the Electoral Districts.*— The number of electors in the year 1999 was 12,071,062. In comparison with 1998, this reflects an increase of 291,862. The increase in the voting strength in the 22 Electoral Districts has varied from 1.54% to 3.72%. For comparative figures on the number of electors from 1990 to 1999, please see Table III.
- 2:2:5 *Performance of the Enumerators.*— The total number of enumerators who were engaged in the enumeration of electors in the year 2000 was 13,271. Of these, 87 were Special Enumerators, 11,948 enumerators succeeded in completing the revision and handing over the revised documents to the District Election Officers, during the stipulated period 50 Grama Niladaris who failed to perform the duties satisfactorily were reported to the District Secretaries for disciplinary action by the respective Assistant Election Commissioners.
- 2:3 It is obvious that the time has come to review the revision procedure under the provisions of the Registration of Electors Act No. 44 of 1980. While no co-operation or constructive criticism has been forthcoming from political parties, with regard to annual revision which takes place in consideration of qualifications fulfilled on a specified date to a specific address, electors themselves become disinterested in this regard even if their names are deleted from the list owing to their indifference or lack of interest. Only at the time when official poll cards for an impending election are despatched by post electors make query about non receipt of such poll cards. Please see Appendix I for the views of the Commissioner of elections, in this regard.

### **3. Disenfranchisement**

Action was taken to delete names of 02 persons, from the Electoral Register, whom the Judiciary notified as having been found guilty of election offences and allegations of bribery during the year 2000. For details please see Table No. XVI.

### **4. Extracts of Electoral Registers**

The total number of extracts of the Electoral Registers issued during the year 2000 was 95,394. Comparative figures for the period from 1991 to 2000, regarding the number of extracts issued and the revenue accrued there from are at Table No. VIII.

### **5. Order in terms of Article 98(8) of the Constitution of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka**

The notification in terms of Article 98(8) of the Constitution of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka was published in *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 1139/19 dated 06.07.2000. Please see Table No. XIV for details. Comparative details for the period 1991 to 1999 are at Table No. XV.

### **6. Recognition of Political Parties**

It was during this year that a decision was taken with regard to the application submitted last year by the Eksath Sinhala Maha Sabha for recognition. While this party was recognised it was allocated the symbol, "Fountain Pen".

In addition to the party named above 42 applications for recognition were submitted during the year under reference. The 08 political parties listed below were accorded recognition and the symbols indicated against their names were allocated to them after inquiry.

## 7. Parliamentary General Election

- 7:1 The term of office of the tenth Parliament was due to expire on 28.08.2000. According to the proclamation for the dissolution of Parliament published by Her Excellency the President in *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 1148/26 dated of 18.08.2000, nominations were received from 28.08.2000 until 12.00 noon of 04.09.2000 and elections were held on 10.10.2000.
- 7:2 The number of Members of Parliament to be elected for each Electoral District at this Parliamentary Election was the number stipulated in the notice published in *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 1139/19 dated 06.07.2000 under Article 98(8) of the Constitution of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka.
- 7:3 The operative Electoral Register 1999, which was certified on 31.05.2000 used for the purposes of this Parliamentary Election. The total number of electors registered therein was 12,071,062. The number of polling stations was 9,946. Furthermore, 76 polling stations were set up under Section 127B of Parliamentary Elections Act for the convenience of 26,832 displaced electors who obtained authority to vote at an alternative polling station. 253,193 applications were accepted to vote by post.
- 7:4 For the first time, stickers bearing a code number was pasted on each official poll card prior to posting them to electors, in order to ensure that these cards are the genuine issues of the Department. Besides, electors of the Electoral District of Jaffna were issued official poll cards different from the other electorates. Further, steps were taken to issue each polling station with a rubber stamp bearing a distinctive official mark on each instead of the usual perforators which were in use so far, to punch the officail mark.
- 7:5 415 polling stations in the Electoral District of Jaffna within the Administrative District of Jaffna, and 53 in the District of Kilinochchi. Of the latter, voting was not conducted in 45 polling stations owing to lack of sufficient security in the area and the polling of these stations was declared null and void. Out of the 50 polling stations in the polling division of Mulativu of the Electoral District of Vanni was not possible to conduct the poll in 49 polling stations; therefore here too the polling was declared null and void. In addition, owing to the incidents that occurred during the poll in 14 polling stations in the Electoral District of Kandy, 01 polling station in the Electoral District of Matale, 04 polling stations in the Electoral District of Nuwara Eliya

and one polling station in the Electoral District of Hambantota was declared null and void in terms of Section 48A of the Parliamentary Election Act, No. 01 of 1981. Notifications setting out the annulment of polling in those polling stations under reference was published in *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 1153/6 dated 12.10.2000.

- 7:6 75.62% (9,128,823) of the total number of registered voters exercised their franchise at the election under review. The voting ratios varied from 21.32% in the District of Jaffna to 83.01% in the District of Moneragala.
- 7:7 The counting of votes was conducted in the District Secretariats and its surrounding Government buildings. The total number of counting centres was 808. The Members elected to the Parliament from amongst the Political Parties and Independent Groups that contested at this election was finalised in the afternoon on 12.10.2000.
- 7:8 A centre was established in the Elections Secretariat, Sarana Mawata, Rajagiriya, Sri Jayawardene pura, to facilitate the verification of elections results and releasing them to the media. the receiving of District level election results was placed in charge of a group of senior public officials. Computer Services Centre of the Institute of Computer Technology of the University of Colombo took necessary action to release the results to the media. The release of official results hitherto limited exclusively to the state media was extended on this occasion to all private media as well.
- 7:9 Polling in 116 stations were declared null and void in terms of Section 48A of the Parliamentary Elections Act. Secretaries of recognised political parties were invited to a consultation, regarding such invalidation, held at 11.30 a.m. of 12th October, 2000. 23 agents of political parties and Independent Groups were present at this discussion. The opinion of the Commissioner of Elections was that it was not possible to decide upon a definite date on which a repoll could be taken and that the polling of 50 such polling stations would not bring any material difference on the overall results. Further informed that the Commissioner of Elections would instruct the Returning Officers concerned to release the results, the total number of electors are taken into consideration and repoll in those polling stations would not bring about any material difference in the final result. For results of the Parliamentary General Election please see Table XVIII.

## 8. Vacancies in the membership of the Sri Lanka Parliament

During the year 2000, 31 vacancies occurred in the membership of the Parliament. For details regarding the filling of such vacancies please see Table IX.

## 9. Vacancies in the membership of Provincial Councils

During the year 2000, 60 vacancies occurred in the membership of Provincial Councils. For details regarding the filling of such vacancies please see Table X.

## 10. Vacancies in the Local Authorities

10.1 *Terms of office of Local Authorities.*—Local Authorities may be classified into four types, according to their terms of office –

- (a) *Local Authorities of which the term of office commenced on 15.04.1997.*— In the case of 13 Municipal Councils, 31 Urban Councils and 195 Pradeshiya Sabhas for which elections were held on 21.03.1997 in all but the North East Provinces, their terms of office are scheduled to terminate on 14.04.2001.
- (b) *Local Authorities of which the term of office commenced on 04.04.1994.*— The terms of office of 40 Local Authorities had been extended up to 03.04.1999 by notification in *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 1016/15 dated 23.02.1998. One Municipal Council, two Urban Councils and 36 Pradeshiya Sabhas in the Eastern Province and the Vavuniya Urban Council in the District of Vavuniya fell into this category. Powers of administering these Local Authorities and powers to exercise the duties and functions conferred upon these Local Authorities by the relevant statutes were devolved upon the Divisional Secretaries by order published in *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 1073/25 of 04.04.1999, in terms of Section 05 of the Public Security Ordinance.
- (c) *Local Authorities of which the term of office commenced on 18.02.1998.*— While 17 Local Authorities including the Pachchilaipalli Pradeshiya Sabha in the District of Kilinochchi and all Local Authorities in the Administrative District of Jaffna where elections were held on 29.01.1998 fall into this category, their terms of office are scheduled to end on 17.02.2002.
- (d) *Local Authorities of which the term of office commenced on 18.02.2000.*— The 14 Local Authorities situated in Administrative

Districts of Kilinochchi, Mannar, Vavuniya and Mulativu where nominations were not submitted even during the second nomination period from July 03rd, 1987, for which the notice in relation to the term of office due to commence on 18.02.2001 was published in the *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 1117/17 dated 18.02.2000 under Section 5 of Public Security Ordinance.

The referenda which were postponed until 16.11.2000 in respect of the Eastern Province and until 01.12.2000 in respect of the Northern Province, by *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 1152/31 dated 21.10.1999, were again postponed until 16.11.2001 in respect of the Eastern Province and until 01.12.2001, in respect of the Northern Province by order published in *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 1156/18 dated 31.10.2000.

## 12. Assets

**Vehicles.**— During the year under review 07 double cabs were purchased for the Department. One cab met with an accident, and it had to be condemned and disposed of, as it was beyond economical repair. Accordingly the total number of vehicles in the possession of the Department remained at 29.

### 13. Staff

Mr. Dayananda Dissanayake, Commissioner of Elections, who was on medical leave from 20.09.1999 reported for duty on 03.01.2000 after total recovery. Mr. D.M.P.B. Dassanayake, Chief Secretary of the Sabaragamuwa Provincial Council, who acted in the post of Commissioner of Elections reverted to his former post.

Miss. J. S. P. A. D. Weerasorriya was appointed to the Post of Systems Analyst with effect from 01.09.2000.

**Note:** Since the establishment of two Pradeshiya Sabhas in the Administrative District of Kilinochchi, all Pradeshiya Sabhas in the Administrative Districts of Mannar, Mullaitivu and all Pradeshiya Sabha in the Administrative District of Vavuniya, no elections have been held. The Notification under Section 5 of the Public Security Ordinance to the effect that their terms of office should commence on 18.02.2001 is published in the Gazette Extraordinary No. 1117/17 of 02.02.2000.

### **Registration of Electors and Electoral Registers**

- 1:1. Electoral registers are revised annually.
- 1:2. The electoral registers are revised and prepared with reference to a qualifying date, i.e., all Sri Lankan Citizens who have attained the age of 18 years on June 1st are eligible to be registered to a qualifying address. (Vide Section 3 and 4 of the Registration of Electors Act, No. 44 of 1980).
- 1:3. It has been generally complained that many persons above the age of 18 years who complete their qualifying age of 18 years on 2nd June of the year of thereafter are deprived of registration. And also those who have changed their residence on 2nd June or thereafter are deprived of registration to the new address during the revision in progress of the current calendar year.
- 1:4. It is true that all persons of the age 18 years on the date of election cannot be brought on to the electoral register and some cut-off date, i.e. qualifying date, has to be fixed.
- 1:5. It is also true that all persons who have changed residence on the date of election cannot be brought on to the present address on the electoral registers and some cut-off date, i.e. qualifying date, has to be fixed.
- 1:6. In order to make provision for many eligible adult Sri Lankan citizens as far as possible, to participate in elections, the Commissioner of Elections recommend that a base register should be prepared on the mid year qualification (both on age and residence qualification) of an appointed year. Thereafter qualifying dates should be fixed as many as four i.e. January 1st, April 1st, July 1st and October 1st of the year with reference to any one of which the Commissioner of Elections may direct an electoral register to be revised and certified, keeping in view the fact that as to when an election is to be held. This will help in keeping with the qualifying date as near as possible to the date of election.
- 1:7. It was observed in the past that the electors generally take an interest regarding their registration only at an election in the event of non receipt of official poll cards.
- 1:8. Though Commissioner of Elections appeals to the Secretaries of recognised political parties to appoint their agents at polling district level in order to assist the enumerators and bring any lapses to the notice of the Registering Officer, the request is disregarded or send the nomination only after the event. Further those who appointed in time also do not take any serious interest at the time of enumeration. This has been reiterated year after year by the Commissioner of Elections in his annual Administration reports.
- 1:9. In order to prevent the deletion of already registered names of a given address the present system of annual registration should be replaced with a system which would allow continuous or 'rolling' registration. The significant feature of this system is the ability to update the register as a continuing process, which has the support of most electoral administrators in various countries.
- 1:10. In order to accommodate the above procedure a Base Register of Electors has to be prepared after giving due publicity prior to the commencement of such revision through Print and Electronic media as the revisions thereafter will be done non-intensively year after year. The Base Registers are kept updated on the information provided by the newly qualified persons on age or those who claim new qualifying addresses.

- 1.11. In order to keep the accuracy of records under a rolling register it should include provision for an annual audit (including canvas) the providing facility to any elector to make a claim or objection with satisfactory proof of evidence to the Registering Officer. the Registering Officer shall after making such inquiry and having satisfied, allow the claim or objection. The decision should be communicated in writing to the person concern.
- 1:12. In order to ascertain the accuracy of information the Registering Officer shall be entitled to request information from Local Authorities, Government Agencies or from any Member of the Public.
- 1:13. When the electoral registers are revised throughout the year and they are exhibited at several appointed places enabling non-registered qualified persons to apply for registration and also enabling any person to object to the entry or retention to the name of his own or any other person appearing in such register, it will not cause apathy on the part of electors, enumerators and political parties. Application forms for claims and objections can be made available at public offices such as Post Offices, Grama Niladhari's Offices, Divisional Secretariats and District Elections Offices.
- 1:14. These provisions will facilitate the persons qualified on age or change of residence seeking inclusion of their names after the last qualifying date. On the other hand objections to any wrong entry of a name in the register seeking deletion of such name.
- 1:15. It has been generally experienced that the names of dead electors whose names are included in the operative register. There is no legal provisions for the deletion of relevant entries even though such details are reported to the registering Officer.
- 1:16. In order that the Names of dead voters are removed from the electoral register, it may be made obligatory on the part of the Registrar of Births and Deaths and the Grama Niladhari of the relevant Wasama/Division where the death took place to furnish information of all deaths registered by them at least four times in a year by the last day of the months of March, June September and December respectively to the Registering Officer of the District.
- 1:17. Electoral Registers are now being revised every year and the Department of Elections incurred Rs. 42,397,821 in the year 1998. i.e.Rs. 3 Cts 60. per Voter. The scheme suggested in paras 1.6, and 1.11 would save this large sums of money and also an elector who has been already registered is assured his name will retain unless he makes a claim to a new residence or reported deceased by the Registrar General or Grama Niladhari.
- 1:18. Commissioner of Elections is of the considered opinion that making it mandatory to furnish information of the National Identity Card at the enumeration or making claims for the inclusion of name/names. The unique number and the name in the National Identity card will facilitate to eliminate any duplication or multiplication within a Polling Division or with another Polling Division.
